Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending July 31, 1993, amounted to 698,839 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of July was 694,466 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 3,590,244 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles was 3,297,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 270,400 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(93)-07", dated August 25, 1993.
