Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending December 31, 1993, amounted to 791,506 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of December was 623,949 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 11,890,734 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles was 3,179,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 556,500 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(93)-12", dated January 27, 1994.
