Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ended June 30, 1994, amounted to 1,035,955 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of June was 648,790 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 3,579,676 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 3,075,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 855,300 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(94)-6", dated July 27, 1994.
