Cotton consumed during the month ending July 31, 1994, amounted to 741,236 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of July was 652,282 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 2,485,815 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles was 3,013,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 610,800 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(94)-7", dated August 24, 1994.
