FIFA Beach Soccer World Cup Bahamas 2017







Slot Allocation

The slot allocations per confederation have been decided by the FIFA Council as follows:

CONFEDERATION	NUMBER OF TEAMS	QUALIFIED TEAMS
AFC	3	AFC 1, AFC 2, AFC 3
CAF	2	Senegal, Nigeria
CONCACAF	2	Mexico, Panama
CONMEBOL	3	Brazil, Paraguay, Ecuador
OFC	1	Tahiti
UEFA	4	Poland, Portugal, Switzerland, Italy
HOSTS	1	Bahamas

Allocation to pots:

The 16 qualified teams are allocated to four pots of four teams each, based on the Beach Soccer Overall World Ranking published on 27 February 2017 http://www.beachsoccer.com/ranking/overall .

Based on the above ranking, the three top teams and the hosts are allocated to Pot 1, the next highest ranked four teams to Pot 2 and so on.

^{*}The three slots reserved to the AFC teams are based on the three best ranked AFC teams on the Beach Soccer Overall World Ranking. The three teams who will qualify will be allocated AFC 1, AFC 2 and AFC 3 in the same order as they finish the 2017 AFC Beach Soccer Championship (Winner, runner up, third place).

Draw mechanics:

- The four pots representing the teams are labelled Pots 1 to 4.
- The four pots representing the groups are labelled Groups A to D. In each pot, there are four balls which contain the position numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4 of each respective group.
- The draw starts with Pot 1 and ends with Pot 4. Each team pot is completely emptied before moving on to the next team pot.
- A ball from a team pot will be drawn, followed by a ball from one of the groups, thus determining the position in which the respective team will play



Draw Constraints

- 1- In Pot 1, Bahamas are in a red ball and have been pre-assigned to position A1 as hosts.
- 2- FIFA's general principle is to ensure that no group has more than one team from the same confederation drawn into it.
