

## PROPOSED RATE MODELS

As part of the I/DD Waiver Amendment, proposed rate models are available for review and public comment. These models are based upon a detailed review of service requirements, meetings with a provider advisory group to discuss service delivery and costs, administration of a provider survey to collect data related to costs and other factors, provider site visits, and identification and analysis of other sources of information that influence the rates. The rate study was completed by Burns & Associates, Inc.
