State Comptroller's Municipal Audit Director Wins Prestigious Speaking Award

Dennis F. Dycus, director of the state Comptroller's Division of Municipal Audit, was recently honored as the 2010 James R. Baker Outstanding Speaker of the Year Award at the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners' (ACFE) annual conference in Washington, D.C.

The ACFE presents the award each year to an individual who has demonstrated the true spirit of leadership in communication, presentation and quality instruction.

The late James Baker, who was a faculty member at the ACFE, received his namesake award in 2008, the year of its inception. Mr. Baker was recognized for his contribution to the education of fellow anti-fraud professionals.

The ACFE recognizes its members who have displayed exceptional achievement in preventing, detecting and investigating fraud with annual awards. The recipients all share in the common belief of contributing significantly to the anti-fraud profession and the discipline of fraud examination.
