Comptroller's Office to Host TIF Luncheon

The Tennessee Comptroller's Office is inviting public officials, financial and legal professionals, business leaders, developers and Tennessee citizens to a luncheon on Tax Increment Financing (TIF) on October 13, 2015 from Noon-1 p.m.

Tax Increment Financing is a tool used by local governments to clear blight or promote housing or economic development in targeted areas using future property tax revenues.

The Uniformity in Tax Increment Financing Act of 2012 requires the Comptroller and the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to review certain TIF plans. The purpose of the luncheon will be to explain the Comptroller's role in this process.

Newcomers will learn more about the TIF process, and experienced professionals will become more informed about how the TIF Uniformity Act is being implemented.

The TIF Luncheon will be held in the James K. Polk State Office Building, 505 Deaderick Street, 16th Floor, Video Conference Center.
