Henry County Receives Clean Audit Report

The Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury is recognizing a significant achievement by Henry County government leaders and elected officials.

Henry County's audit report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 contains no audit findings. Only five Tennessee counties audited by the Comptroller's Office can claim this distinction.

Henry County's previous annual audit included three findings, all of which have been corrected. Leaders have made a commitment to identify and reduce risk through a strong system of internal controls.

"I applaud everyone associated with Henry County government for this excellent report," Comptroller Justin P. Wilson said. "Henry County joins a select group of Tennessee counties that can claim to have one of strongest systems of county government in the state."

The Tennessee Comptroller's Office audits 89 of Tennessee's 95 counties. Henry County joins Weakley County, Sullivan County, Blount County and Tipton County as the only counties who have received clean reports in fiscal year 2015.
