Polygraph Examiner Requirements

LICENSE CATEGORIES

Class I license - Authorizes an individual to administer psycho physiological detection of deception examinations for all purposes which are permissible under the provisions of this article and other applicable laws and rules.

Class II license - Authorizes an individual who is a full-time employee of a law-enforcement agency to administer psycho physiological detection of deception examinations to its employees or prospective employees only.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1.) Is at least eighteen years of age.
- 2.) Is a citizen of the United States of America.
- 3.) Has not been convicted of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or a felony.
- 4.) Has not been dishonorably discharged from the Armed Forces.
- 5.) Has completed a six month internship with a licensed West Virginia polygraph examiner.
- 6.) Has passed the West Virginia Division of Labor Polygraph Exam.

FORMS REQUIRED:

- Completed Polygraph Examiner's application.
- Completed Code of Ethics Form.
- Completed Polygraph Affidavit.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Copy of your Birth Certificate.
- Recent full face photograph. (no larger than 3 X 4)
- Copy of appropriate Degree
 - o Baccalaureate Degree required for Class I
 - Associate Degree required for Class II
- Verification of graduation from a school of polygraphy accredited by the American Polygraph Association.
- Payment of the \$100.00 application fee. ('Checks should be made payable to the West Virginia Division of Labor).
