At noon, in a surprise raid, the Second Specialized Prosecutor Against Organized Crime searched our offices and our employees to collect evidence that should already be located at the Criminal Division of the Institute of Forensic Medicine and Forensic Sciences after the last raid in April of last year.

Mossack Fonseca will always prioritize its continued cooperation with the authorities conducting their investigations, but we categorically reject today's arbitrary and biased action.

Despite this, our founders Jürgen Mossack and Ramón Fonseca will voluntarily attend the prosecutor's office at the Avesa building this afternoon as a demonstration of our infallible commitment to transparency and justice, confident that the investigation will only confirm our innocence.

We reiterate that, in our view, all the actions that the prosecution has taken against the firm today are an attempt to divert the attention from those who really merit a deep and proactive investigation from the authorities on crimes that have already been confessed.

In the more than ten months since the beginning of this investigation, caused by a suspiciously unreported crime committed against our firm, they have not presented a single piece evidence that shows us guilty.
