■ The negotiation mandate requested to the Board of Directors that was approved

However, the parties reached an agreement in September 2013 for a period of three (3) years ending June 30, 2016.

- The APS is a Canada-wide union which consists of 80 % of professionals (engineers, computer scientists, architects, finance employees, project managers, etc.) and 20% of supervisors (team leaders, technical directors, etc.) for a total membership of 655.
- The majority of professionals work in the IT sector and the majority of supervisors are Technical Directors. It should be noted that the role of
