1 CBC (Radio-Canada



- The collective agreement between Radio-Canada and the Syndicat des communications de Radio-Canada (SCRC) expired on September 30, 2012.
- On February 22, 2013, the SCRC rejected an offer to renew the existing collective agreement as is for a one (1) year period.
- To date, the parties have met over thirty (30) times.
- On October 1, 2013, the labour minister appointed two (2) mediators to help the parties renew the collective agreement. Following these appointments, the Corporation considerably lowered its demands.
- On November 19, 2013, after ten (10) days of intensive, mediated bargaining, the Corporation tabled a comprehensive final offer.
- The comprehensive final offer will be put to the union's general assembly on November 30, 2013.
