Q.4 There will be an initiative on the ballot next November concerning marijuana law in Oregon. Let me read you a brief description of this initiative.

This measure would regulate marijuana in a similar manner to alcohol by making the possession of marijuana legal in the state of Oregon for adults age 21 or older, regulating the licensing of marijuana businesses through the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and taxing the production of marijuana. Tax revenues would be distributed to public schools, law enforcement, cities and counties, and mental health and substance abuse programs. This measure would allow the production of homegrown marijuana for personal, noncommercial use if the marijuana is not in public view and the household quantities do not exceed specified limits. This measure would prohibit the sale or possession of marijuana to minors, maintain penalties for driving under the influence of marijuana and retain the right of employers to enforce drug-free workplace policies.
