It is only due to the keen interest of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri.Digamber Kamat and Shri.Prasad Lolayekar, Director of Art & Culture Department that TAG could achieve a lot within a short span of 3 years.

Report of the Activities

General Information

The Konkani Tiatr has proved to be the most popular dramatic form of Goa. Till today there exists no other dramatic form which attracts Goans in such large numbers. Therefore, the production of the Tiatrs has increased manifold in the State of Goa

Tracing the interesting history of the Tiatr, we come to know that it came into existence in the year 1892 in Mumbai. It has survived without any support from the Government or any other institution. Down the years, it has been solely due to people's love that the Tiatr has braved a number of challenges from time to time and has continued to be the most vibrant entertaining dramatic form of Goa

Tiatr lovers and well-wishers have been demanding that the Government support the vital theatre form because of its unique nature and raging popularity among all forms of entertainment in Goa. However, Governments came and Governments went but none of them did anything to support the tiatr while they were in power. Of course, several of them gave assurances which remained unfulfilled.

It is only in 2009 that Shri Digambar Kamat, the Chief Minister of Goa, gave due consideration to the demand. After assessing the importance of Tiatr in Goan society and culture, the Chief Minister realized that it needs government patronage to flourish and finally took a decision to establish the Tiatr Academy of Goa.

The Art & Culture Department constituted a committee under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister Digambar Kamat for the purpose of drafting the constitution for the proposed academy. The other members of the committee were:-

The committee drafted the constitution and the same was registered under 'Societies Registration Act, 1860 (XXI of 1860)' under no. 85/Goa/2009 on 2nd February 2009.

- Government issued another order bearing No.DAC/TA/2007/Part-I/3848 dated 06-01-2009 nominating Shri Tomazinho Cardozo the President of newly formed Tiatr Academy of Goa.

6. Inauguration of TAG

An impressive ceremony on the occasion of the inauguration of Tiatr Academy of Goa was held on 16th February 2009 at Pai Tiatrist Joao Agostinho Fernandes Auditorium, Ravindra Bhavan, Margao.

Shri. Digambar Kamat, Hon. Chief Minister of Goa inaugurated the Tiatr Academy by lighting the traditional lamp in the presence of Master Vaz, the veteran tiatr artiste, Tomazinho Cardozo, President of TAG and Roseferns, Vice-President of TAG. Tiatr personalities of yester years were felicitated on the occasion by the Hon. Chief Minister. The Home Minister Shri. Ravi Naik and Commissioner of NRI Affairs Shri. Eduardo Falleiro also graced the function.

The inaugural function was followed by the Mega Musical Programme of Konkani Song and Skits staged by the topmost artistes of tiatr stage. The inauguration was witnessed by houseful audience of Ravindra Bhavan.

- 7. The Government under the leadership of Shri Digambar Kamat sanctioned a one-time grant of Rs.1.5 crore by order No.DAC/4TA/2007/Part-I/Part file/5145 dated 18-03-2009. The one-time grant was meant for the purchase of a new office premises for Tiatr Academy of Goa, interior decoration of the office and for the purchase of a car for Tiatr Academy of Goa.
- An area of 236 sq. metres was purchased for the office premises in Block A, 2nd Floor, Campal Trade Centre, Campal, Panaji-Goa, from Smt Maria Zurana Pinto. The sale deed was signed on 08-12-2009.
- The new office premises and the Conference Hall of Tiatr Academy of Goa were inaugurated by the Honorable Chief Minister of 16th February 2010 exactly after one year of the establishment of the Academy.
- 10. The Tiatr Academy of Goa functions from this office since February 16th, 2010. The Conference Hall is also used by the Academy as well as by others for conducting various tiatr-related activities.

Implementation of these schemes was very important. Therefore this report gives detailed information of implementation of each and every scheme formulated by TAG.



Oral Documentation of history of Tiatr

The TAG is of the opinion that the veteran Tiatr artistes, who are still living, can provide us with a huge amount of important and relevant information about the Tiatr, its Song & Music, because they have served the Tiatr for a long time. Hence the TAG has decided to record the oral documentation by interviewing the veteran artistes. These artistes include writers, directors, actors, singers, musicians, persons involved in stage setting, light effects, background music, etc. Subsequently, DVDs are produced for preservation of this oral history.

Quotations were asked from videographers in order to make documentaries on the lives of tiatr artistes of yester year by recording their experiences on a digital video disc (DVD). The lowest tender was received from Shri Gasper D' Souza, who was allotted the work of completing the documentation.

Documentation of Tiatr through Research Work

The written documentation of the Tiatr, its song and its music will be preserved for posterity by publishing books relating to its history, its critical appreciation and any other relevant topic.

2009-10

It was brought to the notice of the TAG that Dr. Andre Rafael Fernandes, Professor in Goa University, has completed his thesis on the tiatr for his doctorate. This being an important work of research, the TAG decided to publish the thesis into a book. Dr. Andre Rafael Fernandes agreed to the proposal. Official offer for publishing the book was given to Dr.Rafael Fernandes. As the book could not be completed, the same could not be released in 2009-10.

2010-11

Dr.Rafael Fernandes completed the manuscript of his book and the book 'When the Curtains rise....Understanding Goa's Vibrant Konkani Theatre' was released on 17th April 2010 on the occasion of Tiatr Day.

This publication gives an indepth information of the history of the Tiatr and it provides the reader with immense knowledge of numerous aspects of Tiatr, its song and music.

'When the Curtains rise.... Understanding Goa's Vibrant Konkani Theatre', we are confident, will help the students of Tiatr its song and music to have a thorough glance of the history of Tiatr.

2011-12

Two books of research work were published by TAG on 16th December 2011 at the Conference Hall of TAG. The books were released at the hands of Dr.Francisco Colaco, an eminent cardiologist and cultural activist. The books are:-

- 'Konkani Gramophone Records' is a detailed information of Konkani Gramophone Records since 1910 i.e. when the first Konkani gramophone record was produced. It is compiled by Felix Correia and Franklin D'Souza.
- 'Fell vo Khell' is a study of Goan folk drama. 'Fell vo Khell' written in Konkani in Roman script by veteran Khell Tiatrist Benicio Vitorino Pereira.



Preservation of Tiatr Literature

It is a pertinent fact that Tiatr literature needs to be preserved for posterity. This task will be accomplished by publishing books of the scripts of Tiatrs, one-act plays and lyrics of songs, with or without musical scores, etc. The production of such books will be financed by the TAG.

TAG announced the scheme in the local press and numerous writers of tiatr submitted their manuscripts for publishing in the book form.

Promotion of Tiatr through Academic Activities

The improvement of the standard of Tiatr in all respects is the need of the hour. To achieve this, the TAG will organize workshops/seminars, etc, in different educational institutions as well as in other places, on the various aspects of Tiatr such as script-writing, acting, direction, light effects, stage setting, back ground music, etc. Renowned theatre personalities well versed in theatre in other languages will be invited as resource persons if and when needed.

2009-10

- Under the scheme, two workshops have been organized. The first workshop took place at Our Lady of Rosary Higher Secondary School, Navelim with Shri Premanand Sangodkar and Shri Wilson Mazarello as the resource persons. The workshop was a grand success in that 56 students participated and received instructions from the two experts.
- The second workshop was organised at St. Xavier's College in Mapusa.
 The resource persons included Shri Premanand Sangodkar, Fr. Nevel Gracias and Shri Anil Kumar. In all, 74 students participated in the workshop.

The Principal of St. Xavier's College, Fr Walter D'Costa, was quite impressed by the workshop and showed keen interest in promoting tiatr activities in the college.

Both workshops, helped in creating awareness about Tiatr, its Song and Music among the students of these two institutions.

Workshop on writing Konkani in Roman script

Tiatr Academy of Goa (TAG) organized a special workshop exclusively for tiatrists on writing Konkani in Roman script correctly. The workshop was held on 07th June 2010 at 10:00 am at TAG's Conference Hall, Campal Trade Centre, Panjim. In all 42 tiatr artistes attended the workshop.

Shri. Tomazinho Cardozo, President of Tiatr Academy of Goa, guided the participants. It is a fact that tiatr artistes did not have any formal studies of Konkani in Roman script and hence they write in different ways. Shri. Cardozo put before the participants basics of writing correct Konkani in Roman script.

Correct formation of sentences, use of 'C', and 'Y' alphabets were discussed thoroughly. So also the use of consonants for writing correct pronunciations of different words, were also discussed. The exercises in writing different words and sentences were also conducted. The participants actively interacted with the Resource person. The participants expressed that the workshop was effective in learning various aspects of writing Konkani in Roman script correctly.

· Workshop on Khell-Tiatr

A workshop on 'Khell', 'Khell-Tiatr'/Non-Stop Drama was organised jointly by Kala Academy, Tiatr Academy of Goa (TAG) and Dalgado Konknni Akademi on 29th August 2010 at the Black Box, Kala Academy. The resource persons were Mr. Vitorino Pereira, Mr. Patrick Dourado and Mr.Ligorio Fernandes. The workshop was chaired by Mr. Anil Kumar

Mr. Vitorino Pereira, Mr. Patrick Dourado and Mr.Ligorio Fernandes gave their presentation regarding a traditional 'Khell', 'Khell-Tiatr'/Non-Stop Drama. In order to equip the writers/directors of tiatrs to make use of light effects scientifically, a one day workshop on light effects was organized by Tiatr Academy of Goa (TAG) in collaboration with Ravindra Bhavan, Margao for the benefit of writers/producers and directors of tiatr. The workshop

The valedictory function of the workshop on 14th May 2011 was held at TAG's Conference Hall. Shri. Domnic Coelho, Ace comedian of the tiatr stage was the Chief Guest for the function.

Steve Rod, Jose Salvador Fernandes and Elliton Fernandes, all participants of the workshop expressed their satisfaction for the training achieved in different aspects of producing a drama.

In all 24 participants attended the workshop. The participants were awarded certificates of participation. TAG also reimbursed the to and fro bus transport traveling expenditure incurred by the participants.

6 days Workshop on Tiatr in Margao

A 6 days workshop on 'Acting in Tiatr' was organized by Tiatr Academy Goa in collaboration with Ravindra Bhavan Margao and Art & Culture Department Government of Goa from 11th July 2011 to 16th July 2011 at the Conference

Hall of Ravindra Bhavan Margao. The sessions started at 3:00 pm and ended at 6:00 pm everyday. The aim in organizing such a workshop was to equip the artistes with scientific methods of acting.

Promotion of Tiatr Music

TAG has observed that the number of musicians playing the blowing/wind instruments such as Trumpet and Saxophone is decreasing rapidly. Hence the TAG has formulated a scheme to encourage youth and others to learn to play the blowing instruments, particularly Trumpet and Saxophone, by providing them with financial assistance.

Under the scheme aimed at promoting music, the tuition fees will be paid by the TAG, and if need be, even the musical instrument will be provided to the students who cannot afford to purchase the same.

The striking feature of this scheme is that when any student completes his/her learning, he/she has to compulsorily play for tiatr performances for a minimum period of one year.

2009-10

There was only one student who showed keen interest in learning to play the trumpet in the year 2009-2010. He is Mr. Shaik Anif. However, the scheme gained popularity in due course of time., and for the next financial year 2010-2011 the TAG has admitted 12 more students, who hare interested in learning to play the trumpet, the saxophone and the clarinet.

Financial Assistance to dramatic troupes participating in Kala Academy's Yearly Tiatr Festival

TAG has observed that the tiatrs staged at the yearly Tiatr Festival of Kala Academy Goa are of good standard. It is also observed that the non-commercial artistes participating in this festival take keen interest and make a lot of sacrifices in order to stage a good performance. The expenditure incurred by these institutions also is quite high.

Therefore, in order to provide financial support to dramatic troupes participating in the festival, TAG decided to give Rs.10,000/- to each of the participating troupes provided they comply with the rules and regulations of this scheme.

Financial assistance to troupes going to Mumbai/Poona and other parts of the country & vice versa

The Goan Tiatr took birth in the Bombay city. There was a time when the Tiatr culture was much more prominent in Bombay than in Goa. Drama troupes from Bombay used to tour Goa regularly to stage their tiatrs. In the recent years, however, the scenario has reversed completely. Nowadays, the popular drama troupes from Goa visit Bombay and Pune at regular intervals to entertain Goan audiences with their plays in the two cities. The situation has changed while there is still a demand for tiatr in those cities. However, many a time, the staging of tiatrs in Bombay/Pune by Goan dramatic troupes is not a financially viable proposition.

Therefore the TAG has introduced a scheme to give financial support to the tune of Rs.25,000 (Rupees twenty-five thousand only) to any drama troupe desirous of going to Bombay/Pune to stage tiatrs, provided that at least five shows of the same tiatr are staged during a single trip.

In order to serve the tiatr lovers in other parts of the country, TAG will also provide financial support of Rs.25,000 (Rupees twenty-five thousand only), even if one show of the tiatr is staged, in more distant places like Bangalore, Kolkata, Delhi, Gujarat and Nagpur.

This scheme is also applicable to dramatic troupes from Mumbai coming to Goa and other parts of the country.

Preference will be given to those who organise such programmes on the birth day of the concerned artiste.

As per this scheme, TAG gives financial support to the tune of Rs.20,000/and the auditorium to troupes/institutions/individuals for producing dedicated programmes on the life and work of popular artistes. This programme may include a tiatr, or songs of the artiste. TAG supports such a programme to be staged at three different venues.

Workshop on Kantaram on 8th August 2010

A workshop on stage songs of tiatr 'Kantaram' was organised by Kala Academy Goa in collaboration with Tiatr Academy of Goa (TAG) on 8th August 2010 at the Black Box, Kala Academy, Panjim. 'Kantaram' is a part and parcel of a tiatr, which also constitutes its uniqueness.

'Kantaram' are of different types such as Solos, Duets, Trios, Quartets etc. and all these songs of different types must be included in the tiatr. However in the recent times it has been observed that variety of 'kantaram' which form the uniqueness of tiatr, is not maintained by the present day tiatr artistes.
