#### Media accreditation

UNIS offers annual media accreditation to the Vienna International Centre (VIC) to allow bona fide media representatives access to all organizations' conferences and events at the VIC. Applicants need a valid press card and a letter of assignment from their media organization on official letterhead, and can apply online at: www.unis.unvienna.org/unis/en/media accreditation.html

The accreditation period runs from December until November the following year and can usually be extended from the beginning of November. Journalists should be prepared to provide evidence of regular coverage of United Nations topics. The Security and Safety Service, which issues the VIC grounds passes, also requires the presentation of a national passport.

*Please note:* Once your request has been approved, you will be asked to collect your grounds pass within three months.

# PREPARATORY COMMISSION FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE NUCLEAR-TEST-BAN TREATY ORGANIZATION (CTBTO)

The Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty bans all nuclear explosions — underground, underwater, in the atmosphere and in space. CTBTO promotes the Treaty and is establishing a global verification regime with 337 monitoring sites to ensure that no nuclear explosion goes undetected. # UNITED NATIONS REGISTER OF DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WALL IN THE OCCUPIED PALESTINIAN TERRITORY (UNROD)

UNRoD's mandate is to record, in documentary form, the damage caused to all natural and legal persons as a result of the construction of the Wall by Israel in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including in and around East Jerusalem. By June 2016, more than 55,833 claims had been collected and the Board of UNRoD has reviewed and decided on 22,536 claims for inclusion in the Register.

#### Practical information: services at the Vienna International Centre

All shops and services are open from Monday-Friday unless otherwise stated.

**Banking services:** The two branches of Bank Austria with ATM machines outside are on the first floor of the C-Building (C0113) and on the ground floor of the D-Building. Both are open 9 a.m.—3 p.m., and until 5.30 p.m. on Thursdays.

Catering services: The VIC Cafeteria, on the ground floor, is open 7.30 a.m.–10 a.m. and 11.30 a.m.–2.30 p.m. (Coffee Corner: 8 a.m.–3.30 p.m.). The VIC Restaurant, also on the ground floor of the F-Building, is open 11.30 a.m.–2.30 p.m. Table reservations can be made on the internal extension 4877 (between 10.00 a.m.–3.30 p.m.). The Coffee Bar on the seventh floor of the C-Building is open from 9 a.m.–4.30 p.m. The Coffee Bar on the second and fourth floors of the C-Building are open during conferences. The Coffee Bar on the ground floor of the M-Building is open 9 a.m.–4.30 p.m. The Bar/Cocktail Lounge, on the ground floor of the F-Building is open Mon-Thurs 11.30 a.m.–8 p.m. (7 p.m. in summer), Fri 11.30 a.m.–9 p.m. (8 p.m. in summer)

The **dry-cleaning service**, on the ground floor of the G-Building, is open 11.30 a.m. – 3 p.m.

**International newspapers, magazines and books** are available from the newspaper stand on the ground floor of the Rotunda, which is open 6 a.m—6 p.m.

The **pharmacy**, on the seventh floor of the F-Building, sells over-the-counter and prescription drugs and is open 10 a.m.—5 p.m. Internal extension: 21599.

The **Post Office**, on the first floor of the C-Building (C0101), is open 8 a.m—6 p.m.

**Travel agent:** American Express Travel is located on the ground floor near the Rotunda and is open 8.30 a.m.–5.30 p.m.

**The Vienna Service Office** in the Rotunda provides information about living in Austria. It is open Monday to Thursday, 8.30 a.m.—1.30 p.m. Internal extension: 4234

A hairdressing salon, various gift counters and United Nations postage stamps for sale are available at the Visitors Centre at Gate 1.
