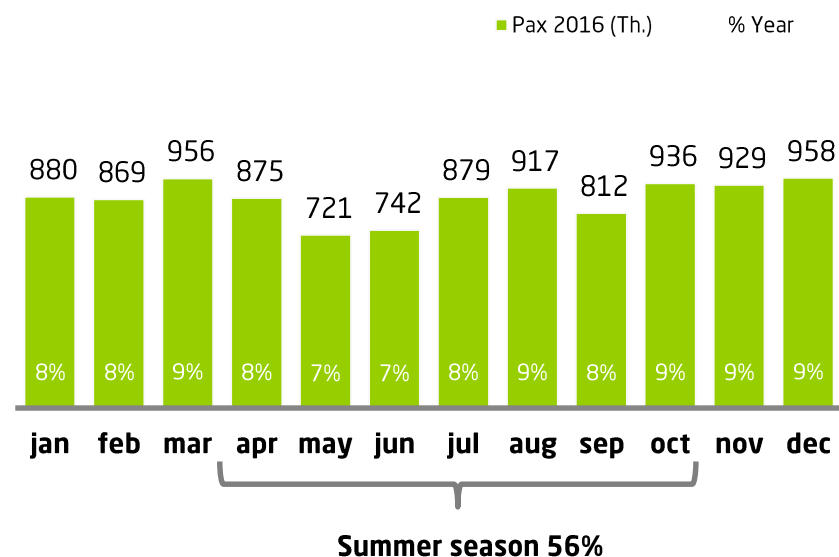

## Monthly traffic evolution

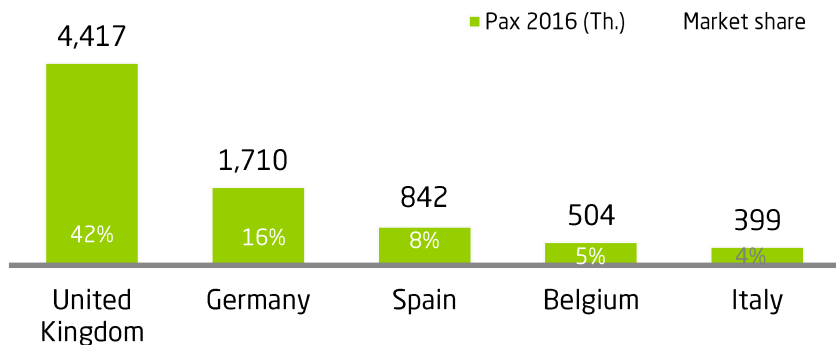

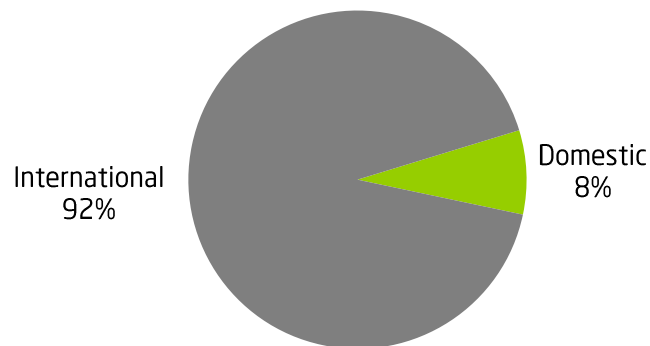

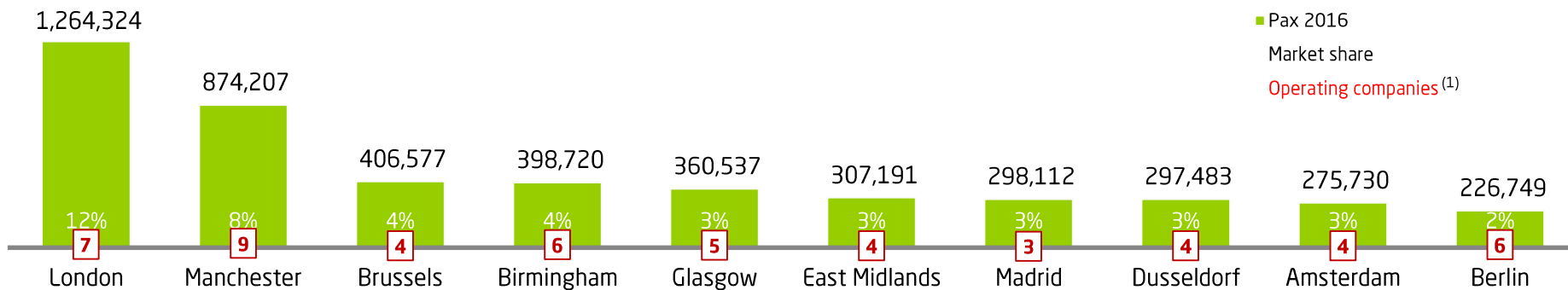


## Traffic distribution

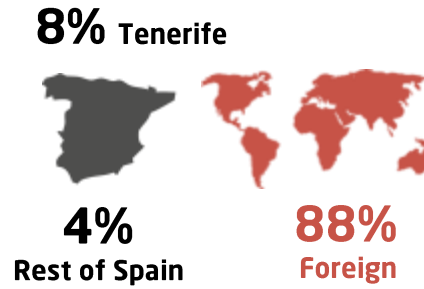

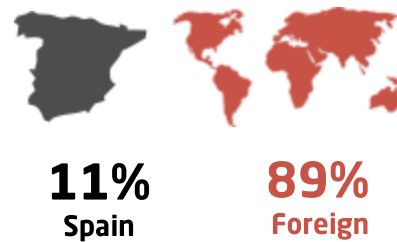

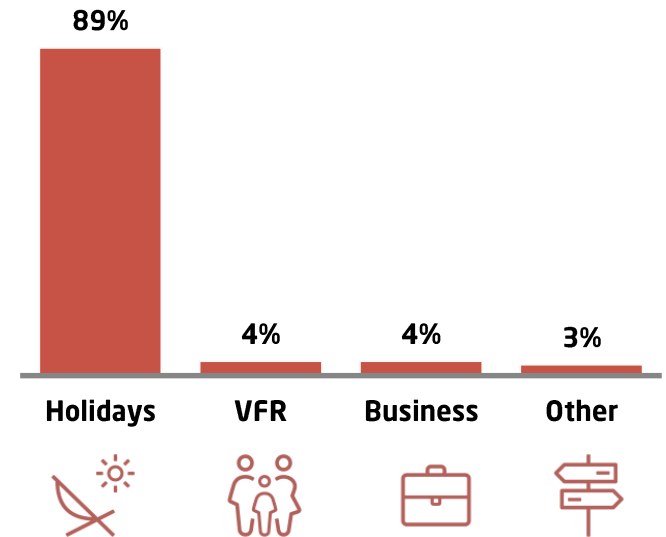
