





Special points of interest:




- Hora de Cuentos program is offered one Saturday a month in the Youth Services Department.
- Friends of the Library sponsored restoration of Map of Easton, 1789 donated to the Marx Room by local historians Richard and Ginny Hope. This is the oldest known map of Easton.
- Library tours offered to local service clubs, cub scout groups, and school groups.
- Eighty volunteers donate their time and talents to the Library in many ways.
- Friends of the Library hosted an evening gardening program with a Master Gardener.
- One to One computer help for patrons is available in the Main Library.
- More eBooks and eMagazines were added to our collection.
- The Friends of the Library raised \$6000 for the Library from used book sales.
- Engineers Without Borders program with Lafayette students and local schoolchildren is held monthly.
- Automatic doors were installed by Palmer Township at the Palmer Branch.
