Property Description	<p>This garden, along with twenty other gardens, were commissioned by the British High Commissioner Alexander Ball to be used by the lieutenants of the said village in commemoration of the expulsion of the French as seen in the inscription on the façade of this particular garden. The façade is further embellished with an escutcheon with the royal cypher of King George III of England which is found above the said inscription. The garden is also surrounded by a high boundary wall. These gardens were also used as botanical gardens, with an irrigation system.</p>
