Lacy Sumper from Needlewoman and Needlecraft, No. 46 1951



MATERIALS.-5 ozs. 2-PLY WOOL. A pair each of Nos.10 and 12 Knitting Needles.

Medium crochet hook.

MEASUREMENTS.—To fit 34 in. Bust. Length $18\frac{1}{2}$ ins. Sleeve seam (with cuff turned up) 6 ins.

TENSION.-1 patt. to 11 (unpressed).

ABBREVIATIONS.—K.—Knit; P.— Purl; st.—stitch; tog.—together; w.r.n.—wool round needle; w.o.n. wool over needle; t.b.l.—through back of loops; wl. fwd.—wool forward; inc.-increase; dec.-decrease; rep.repeat; patt.—pattern; cont.—continue; beg.—beginning; foll.—following.

THE BACK.—Cast on 110 sts. with No. 12 needles and work $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins. K. 1, P.1 rib, dec. evenly along last row to 107 sts.

Change to No. 10 needles. **1st row.**—K.4, * K.2, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.1, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2, rep. from * to last 4 sts. K.4.

2nd and alternate rows .- K.1, Purl to last st. K.1.

3rd row.—K.4, * K.1, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.3, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.1, rep. from * to last 4 sts. K.4.

5th row.—K.4, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.5, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., rep. from * to last 4 sts. K.4.

7th row.—K.4, * K.2, w.r.n. P.2 tog. P.1, P.2 tog. w.o.n. K.2, rep. from * to last 4 sts. K.4. **9th** row.—K.1, inc. in next st. K.2, *

K.3, w.r.n. P.3 tog. w.o.n. K.3, rep. from * to last 4 sts. K.1, inc. in next st. K.2.

11th row.-K.5, * K.3, K.2. tog. wl. fwd. K.2 K.2 tog. wl. fwd. rep. from * to last 5 sts. K.5.

5 sts. K.5. 13th row.—K.5, wl. fwd. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.4, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.1, * w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.4, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.1, rep. from * to last 5 sts. K.5. 15th row.—K.1, inc. in next st. K.3, * P.1, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.2, rep. from * to last 5 sts. K.2, inc. in next st., K.2. 17th row.—K.6, * P.2, wl. fwd. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.3, rep. from * to last 6 sts. K.6. 19th row.—K.6, * P.2 tog. wl. fwd. K.4, w.r.n. P.2 tog. P.1, rep. from * to last 6 sts. K.6.

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21st row.—K.1, inc. in next st. K.3, K.2 tog. * wl. fwd. K.6, w.r.n. P.3 tog. rep. from * to last 14 sts. wl. fwd. K.6, w.r.n. P.2 tog. K.3, inc. in next st. K.2. 23rd row.—K.7, wl. fwd. K.2 tog. K.2, * wl. fwd. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2, wl. fwd. K.2 tog. K.3, rep. from * to last 12 sts. wl. fwd. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2, wl. fwd.

K.2 tog. K. 6. 24th row.-K.1, purl to last st. K.1.


(N.B. These 24 rows form the pattern and when working the following rows the pattern is repeated exactly as from 1st to 24th row, but the extra sts. increased should be kept in stocking stitch).

25th row.—K.7, * K.2, K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.1, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.2, rep. from * to last 7 sts. K.7.

26th row.—K.1, purl to last st. K.1. 27th row.—K.7, * K.1 K.2 tog. w.r.n. P.3, w.o.n. K.2 tog. t.b.l., K.1, rep. from * to last 7 sts. K.7.

28th row.-As 26th.

Cont. in patt. (as from 5th row) inc. one st. at each end of needle in the next and every foll, 6th row until there are 131 sts. (keeping the inc. sts. in stocking st.). Cont. without shaping until the work measures 121 ins. from beg. ending with a purl row.



SHAPE ARMHOLES.

Keeping the panel of patt. cast off 7 sts. at beg. of each of next 2 rows then dec. one st. at each end of needle in the next and every alternate row until 101 sts. remain ***. Cont. without shaping until armholes measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ ins. from casting off ending with a purl row.

SHAPE SHOULDERS.

1st and 2nd rows .- Work in patt. to last 12 sts. turn. 3rd and 4th rows.—Work in patt. to last 12 sts. turn. 3rd and 4th rows.—Work in patt. to last 24 sts. turn. 5th and 6th rows.—Work in patt. to last 34 sts. turn. 7th row.—(K.3, K.2 tog.) 6 times, K.3, work in patt. to end of row. Cast off.

THE FRONT.

Work exactly as for Back as far as ***. Work 6 rows without shaping.

To Shape Neck.

Next row.—K.1, P.33, cast off 33 sts. P. 33, K.1. Cont. in patt. on last 34 sts. without shaping until armhole measures same as that of back, ending at neck edge. Work 2 more rows.

Shape Shoulder.

1st row.-Work to last 12 sts. turn. 2nd row.-Work to end of row.

3rd row.—Work to last 24 sts. turn. 4th row.—As 2nd. Cast off.

Join in wool at neck edge of the sts. which were left and work other side of neck to correspond (reversing shapings).

THE COLLAR.-Cast on 197 sts with No. 12 needles. **1st row.**—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st. K.1. **2nd row.**—K.1, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to end of row. Cont. in rib dec. one st. at each end of needle in the next and every alternate row until 175 sts. remain. Work 1 more row in rib. Cast off.

THE CUFFS .- Cast on 133 sts. with No. 12 needles and work 1st and 2nd rows of Collar. Cont. in rib dec. one st. at each end of the next and every alternate row until 111 sts. remain. Work 1 more row in rib. Cast off.

THE SLEEVES (Both Alike).

Cast on 89 sts. with No. 12 needles.

Change to No. 10 needles and work from 1st to 7th row of Back. Purl back.

Cont. in patt. inc. one st. at each end of needle in the next and every foll. 4th row until there are 99 sts. (Keeping the inc. sts. in stocking st.).

Cont. without shaping until work measures 6 ins. at side ending with a purl row.

To Shape Top.

Working in patt. cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 4 rows then cast off 1 st. at beg. of foll. 12 rows.

Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 28 rows. (23 sts. remain). Next row.—K.2 tog. (K.1, K.2 tog.) 7 times. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP .- Pin out each piece to size stated and press with a hot iron over a damp cloth. Sew up the side, shoulder and sleeve seams and sew in sleeves. With a medium crochet hook, work 2 rows double crochet across front of neck. Sew on collar and cuffs as illustrated. Press all seams
