THE YEAR IN ARCHERY

mong the many virtues of taking up archery is the camaraderie and fun of club nights. But further down the line, the irresistible urge to discover a competitive edge often consumes many enthusiasts, and this Yearbook is designed to highlight some of the outstanding achievements of many archers over the past 12 months.

From the top down, British archery had much to be proud of in 2010. The undoubted highlight were the medals won at the Commonwealth Games: the individual compound golds of Nicky Hunt and Duncan Busby, the individual recurve silver of Alison Williamson, the men's and women's team golds in the compound tournaments, and the women's recurve team silver medal.

In the World Cup, Simon Terry and Nicky Hunt both qualified for the Grand Final at Edinburgh as of right, and though there were to be no medals at the 2010 FITA extravaganza, all six GB archers taking part did themselves proud. Nicky arrived at Edinburgh as the new world number one, but not even her top ranking could prevent her losing a thrilling first round match to GB colleague Andrea Gales.

The National Series was another great success, culminating in a great day of archery at the Grand Final in Leamington. Rob Hallworth knocked harder on the international door as he went all the way to the final, and actually was in one arrow of sensationally taking the men's recurve title, before Simon Terry fought back to win for the second year running. Sam Meadows made the women's recurve final four, but Naomi Folkard took the title, with Chris White and Nichola Simpson winning the compound.

And so to the National Indoor Championships at Telford in December, held over the same weekend. and at the same venue as the Junior Indoor Championships. What a great weekend of archery,

some eyebrow-raising results throughout the two days, and enormous enthusiasm throughout the hall.

But that's archery enthusiasm all around. Which makes it a wonderful sport, and a consuming pastime!

THE OFFICIAL TARGET ARCHERY RANKINGS 2010



total of 425 archers completed the required shoots for the rankings in 2010, another significant year-on-year increase. There were 85 relevant world record status events held in the UK and details were recorded from 19 events held abroad. Just over 1700 different members attended the shoots.

In addition to compound and recurve listings, the rankings for 2010 include lists for longbow and barebow archers for the first time; although relatively

few in number, these archers now have an official ranking. In a change from previous years, the actual score from the Olympic rounds was not used as the round is now shot in sets, but archers were required to participate in these shoots. Note this means that scores could be up to 240 points lower than last year.

The names at the top of the lists will be familiar to many and there are few surprises in the lists. The leading recurve archers, Simon Terry and Naomi Folkard, continue to hold their positions with authority. For the compounds, after 10 years at the top, Chris White has been dislodged into second place in the gentlemen's list by Duncan Busby – but only just. Nicky Hunt retains her position in the ladies' list.

One archer appears in both the recurve and compound lists – Dot Cooper of Lichfield. Although visually impaired, she has vision enough to aim at the target and so competes on an equal footing with other archers.

In the lists that follow, the points gained represent each archer's best three ladies / gents FITA rounds and best two FITA 70m rounds all from shoots with World Record Status. In addition, archers are required to shoot 2 separate Olympic rounds each associated with a World Record Status qualification round.

The highlights had to be the medal winning performances at the Commonwealth Games, but I must single out Andy Rikunenko's gold medal success at the European Championships, and the 10 medals won by our Paralympians at their European Championships, proving yet again how successful they continue to be.
