Marion County Civil and Criminal Courts on Odyssey

Last year Marion County Civil Courts moved to Odyssey—a statewide judicial case and financial management system. On June 6, 2014, the Criminal Division of the Marion County Superior Court will begin its conversion to Odyssey with full implementation taking effect June 16. The JUSTIS mainframe system will no longer be updated after June 6 but can be accessed during the conversion timeframe (June 6-16, 2014). JUSTIS will be decommissioned on September 30, 2014.

The Indiana Supreme Court only permits Court and Clerk's Office staff access to Odyssey. A free public version can found at http://mycase.in.gov. The public version allows access to basic case data including hearing dates and other matters on the Chronological Case Summary.

All new and active civil and criminal cases can be viewed through mycase.in.gov beginning June 16. Closed civil and criminal cases will continue to be available through indygov.biz for a nominal fee. After September 30, all NEW cases will be accessible through Odyssey.

Former users of JUSTIS may not be able to find all the information they once did on the public site and might need to contact the Clerk's Office to make a records request.
