Tivoli Weowna Park Hat and Scarf

Skill Level:

Beginner/Advanced Beginner

Sizes:

One size fits most adults

Materials:

Cascade Yarns® Tivoli 60% Wool / 40% Silk

100 g (3.5 oz) / 109 yds (100 m)

1 - 3 skeins of color #10 ()

US 9 (5.5 mm) & 10 (6.0 mm) knitting needles

or size to obrain gauge

Crochet Hook, size H or I for CO

Stitch markers Yarn Needle

Gauge:

Hat: 4 sts x 5 rnds = 4" (10 cm) in pattern stitch

Scarf: 6 sts x 9 rnds = 4" (10 cm) in pattern stitch after blocking.

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Abbreviations:

BO = Bind Off CO = Cast On K = Knit

KFB = Knit into the front and back of 1 stitch

P = Purl

PM = Place Marker St(s) = Stitch(es) Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Hat

Using Emily Ocker's Cast On and US 9 knitting needles, CO 9. Being careful not to twist your sts, join in the rnd. PM.

Rnd 1: *[KFB]; repeat to end of rnd. (18 sts.)

Rnd 2: K all sts.

Rnd 3: *[KFB]; repeat to end of rnd. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: K all sts.

Rnd 5: *[KFB]; repeat to end of rnd. (72 sts)

Rnd 6: K all sts.

Work [K2, P2] ribbing to 9" or desired length.

Finishing:

BO in [K2, P2] ribbing pattern.

Weave in ends.

Scarf

Note: Scarf is multiple of 4 + 2 (additional 2 stitches used to balance pattern).

While pattern indicates 2x2 ribbing [K2, P2]; the 1st st of each row should be slipped purlwise with yarn as follows:

If the 2^{nd} st is a knit, slip 1^{st} st purlwise with yarn in back.

If the 2nd st is purl, slip the first st purlwise with yarn in front.

Begin Pattern:

Using US 10 knitting needles, CO 26 sts.

Row 1: *[K2, P2]; repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2: *[P2, K2]; repeat from * to last 2 sts, P2.

Work [K2, P2] ribbing to 60" or desired length.

Note: This is sufficient length to wrap comfortably around the neck twice.

Finishing:

BO in [K2, P2] ribbing pattern.

Weave in ends.
