



**Exports from Maine** helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.



### Maine goods exports in 2016






#### **Exports Support Jobs**

Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

A total of 2,262 companies exported from Maine locations in 2014.





## Maine Employment in Foreign-Owned Companies Number of Employees by Country of UBO




