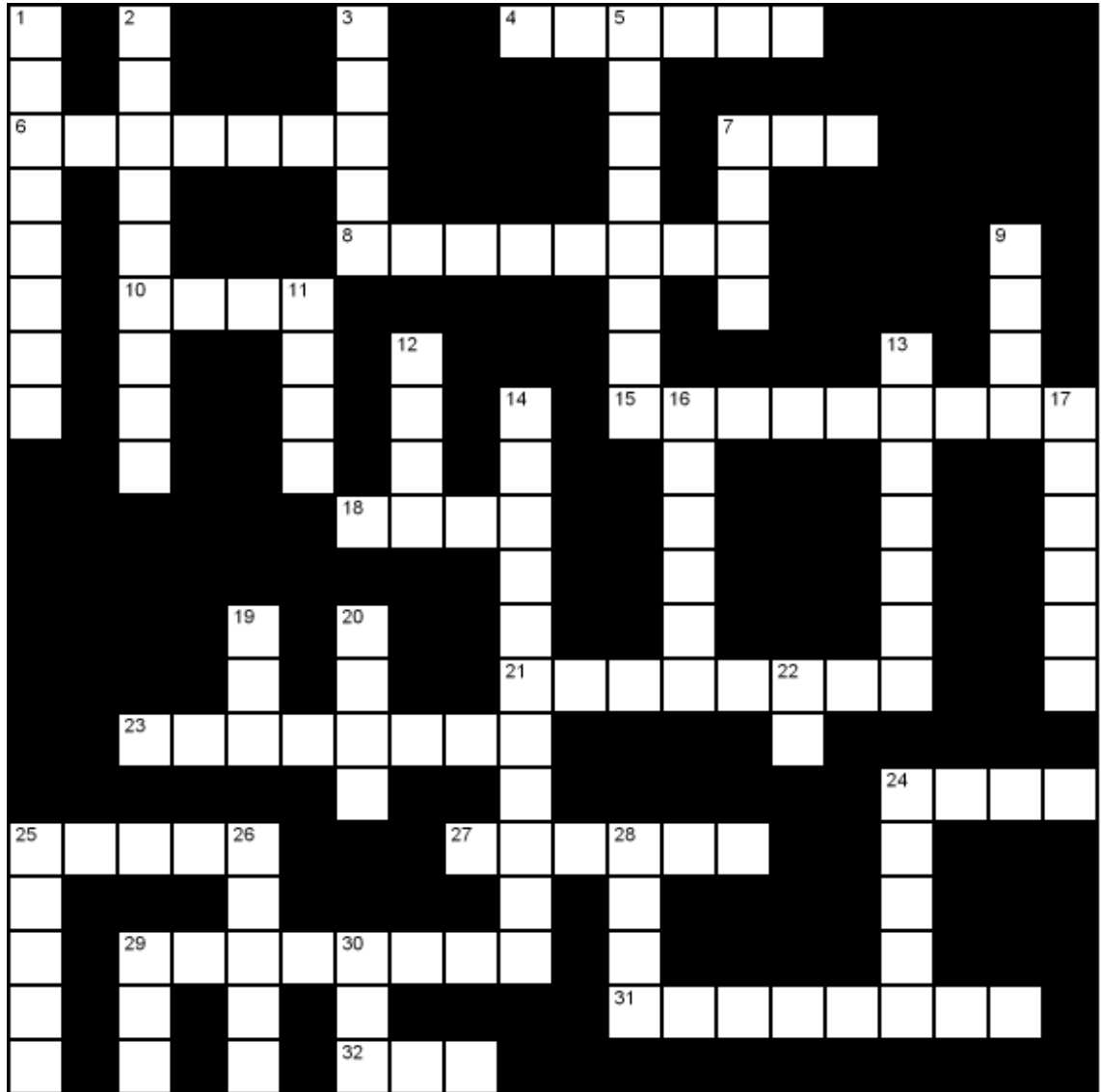


## A48 Love God with Your Whole Heart, Matthew 22:34-40 Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time
