

B21 Doubting Thomas, John 20:19-31, Second Sunday of Easter

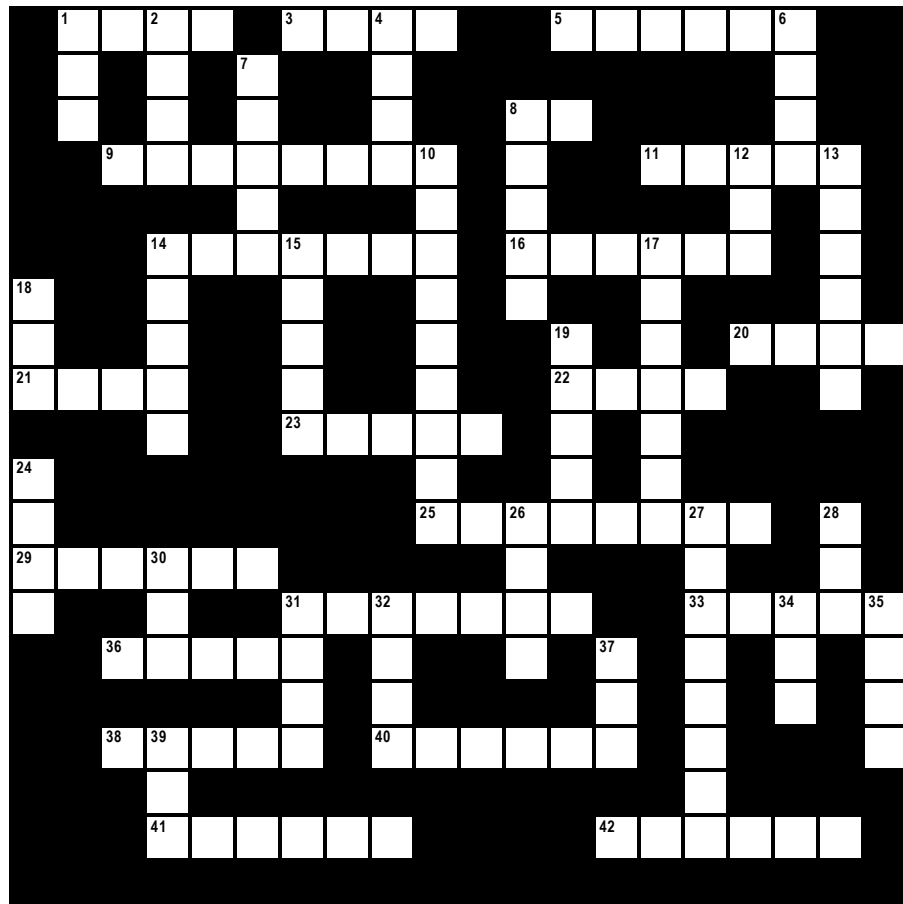
