METHODOLOGY:

The sample size for the survey is 500 likely general election voters in Virginia and the margin of error is +/-4.4%. Reponses were gathered via landline interviews conducted with Interactive Voice Response (IVR) technology. The survey was conducted June 14 - 16, 2017 by Harper Polling. The total percentages for responses may not equal 100% due to rounding.
