

Abellio is one of the leading private railway transport companies in Germany. The company is head-quartered in Berlin and operates rail networks throughout Germany. Abellio has been the national carrier of the DKB Handball-Bundesliga since September 2016. Abellio Rail NRW GmbH in Hagen as well as Abellio Rail Mitteldeutschland GmbH in Halle are responsible for ongoing operations.

> Abellio in the regions

As Abellio Rail NRW, we operate regional rail transport services across several rail lines throughout North Rhine-Westphalia, including in the Emscher-Ruhrtal network with Bochum, Wanne-Eickel and Gelsenkirchen as well as in the Ruhr-Sieg network between Essen, Hagen, Iserlohn and Siegen. We have also been operating the "Der Müngstener" route steeped in tradition since December 2013, running over Germany's highest railway bridge through the towns of Wuppertal, Remscheid and Solingen. From December 2016, we will be responsible for the cross-border short-distance route between Düsseldorf and the Dutch city of Arnhem by operating the Lower Rhine network and from 2018, implement the important "Rhine-Ruhr-Express" mobility project. Abellio will take over the largest batch of the Rhine-Ruhr S-Bahn and will thus become the most important pacesetter for those living in the Ruhr area.

Abellio Rail Mitteldeutschland GmbH has been ensuring mobility for those travelling between Kassel, Halle (Saale), Leipzig, Eisenach, Gotha, Erfurt, Weimar and Saalfeld on the Saale-Thuringia-Südharz electric network since 2015. We will also commence passenger operations on the Saxony-Anhalt diesel network between Harz and Elbe and on to Berlin from 2018.

In 2015, Abellio opened an office in Stuttgart in south west Germany to prepare for entry into the market in Baden-Württemberg from there. With success: We will run the Stuttgart network between Tübingen, Pforzheim, Heidelberg and Mannheim from 2019.

The Westfalenbahn links the cities of Emden, Münster, Bielefeld and Hannover within the Teutoburger-Wald network and the Emsland-Mittelland network.







> We continue to grow dynamically

Abellio has been present in Germany since 2004. The company was able to develop into one of the leading private providers of regional rail transportation with the highest quality requirements within a very short time. And Abellio 2019 Start of operation will continue to grow in the years ahead: The on the Rhine-Ruhr spring of 2017 will see Abellio provide techni-S-Bahn cally sophisticated cross-border traffic through the Lower Rhine region for the first time on the network of the same name, the operation of which will commence in December 2016, and link both Düsseldorf and Mönchengladbach with Arnhem in Holland. From 2018, Abellio will get the Rhine-Ruhr-Express on the tracks and operate the RE 1 and RE 11 lines between Aachen, Düsseldorf, Hamm and Kassel as well as commence travel on the Rhine-Ruhr S-Bahn between Haltern am See, Gelsenkirchen and Wuppertal from 2019.

Abellio is significantly expanding its presence in central Germany, since Abellio trains will not only run in the STS electric network, but also 2019 in the Saxony-Anhalt diesel network from Start of operation 2018. Thousands of passengers will then be on the Stuttgart able to travel with us in Harz and Börde as network / Neckartal well as between the major cities of Erfurt, Magdeburg, Potsdam and Berlin. The Saale-Thuringia-Südharz electric network and the Saxony-Anhalt diesel network are the largest networks, which have ever been awarded to a regional rail transportation company in Germany.

Last but not least, we will also expand in the south west of Germany and present passengers in Baden-Württemberg with an enhancement in rail travel quality. Abellio will operate the Stuttgart network from 2019 and will set new quality standards on the tracks between Tübingen and Mannheim.

> Abellio Rail NRW

Abellio Rail NRW GmbH is the railway subsidiary of the German Abellio GmbH in North Rhine-Westphalia. We currently transport around twelve million passengers across 5.6 million train kilometres per year. Our current route network in NRW stretches from Gelsenkirchen to Bochum, from Essen to Siegen and Iserlohn via Hagen as well as from Wuppertal to Solingen via Remscheid.

Abellio Rail NRW will render an additional 2.7 million train kilometres per year along the Lower Rhine network between Arnhem in Holland and Düsseldorf / Mönchengladbach and Bocholt from December 2016.

The Rhine-Ruhr-Express (RRX) follows with the RE 11 line from December 2018 and the RE 1 line from June 2020. A further 6.2 million train kilometres per year will then be added. Abellio Rail NRW will take over six lines of the Rhine-Ruhr S-Bahn between Dortmund, Wuppertal, Oberhausen and Haltern am See in December 2019, making Abellio the pacesetter for millions of commuters in the Ruhr area.

On the fast track with Abellio

Abellio is growing: We will take up operations in the Saxony-Anhalt diesel network, in the Stuttgart network as well as with the Rhine-Ruhr-Express and Rhine-Ruhr S-Bahn in the coming years. We therefore require competent and committed employees not just for our new routes, but for existing networks too. The current plan foresees more than 500 new jobs in the years ahead.



> Become a part of the Abellio team

We focus on the regions in which we serve when recruiting personnel. In doing so we want to recruit experienced specialists from previous operators and train non-specialist lateral entrants to a qualified level. The collective industrial trade agreement valid across Germany and concluded together with other major rail transport companies and the Eisenbahn- und Verkehrsgewerkschaft (EVG) [German Railway and Transport Union] contains an in-house trade agreement including framework and collective wage agreement. 07. Our Workshops

The safety of our passengers on board our modern, comfortable rail cars is the number one priority for us. Our trains are maintained by our qualified personnel in our very own rail depots in Hagen (North Rhine-Westphalia) and Sangerhausen (Saxony-Anhalt). We are also currently building an additional state-of-the-art rail depot in Duisburg. Completion is scheduled for December 2016, to coincide with the commencement of the Lower Rhine network

> Sangerhausen depot

The 50,000 square meter area immediately adjacent to Sangerhausen station is the technical heart of Abellio Rail Mitteldeutschland. The site was deliberately chosen because the town is situated in the middle of the Saale-Thuringia-Südharz network, thus reducing the distance covered to all points on the route. Regardless of whether it is Saalfeld, Eisenach, Erfurt, Leipzig, Kassel or Halle: the distance to the maintenance workshop is no more than 150 kilometres. The ultra-modern maintenance workshop facilitates all kinds of maintenance and repair work, from the roof to the train interior through to work on the vehicle floor. Our Talent 2 trains arrive in Sangerhausen after every 30 operational days for scheduled inspections. External cleaning facilities and parking areas for trains are found to the east of the two-part facility, which Abellio built in the years 2014/2015. The western side accommodates the 120m long workshop hall.

> Hagen depot

The present operational premises of Abellio Rail NRW in Hagen-Eckesey has been used for railway operations for over 100 years. In the run up to the start of operation on the Ruhr-Sieg network, the premises was sold to Abellio Rail NRW, which built an ultra-modern servicing centre in it's place. Since then, a vehicle exterior cleaning facility with wash water treatment facility, a mobile lifting system to raise trains and a roof working structure have become an indispensable part of the Abellio workshop. The workshop building leaves nothing to be desired in terms of technology, equipment and infrastructure.


> Duisburg depot

A two-track combined servicing and washing hall with a total length of 105 meters has been built at the new Abellio site in Duisburg near the main railway station, covering an area of 5,000 square meters.

A three-floor administrative and social wing, as well as a high-bay warehouse construction, will be built along-side. Twenty-one electrical multiple units for the Lower Rhine network will then be serviced there. Duisburg was chosen as the location for this site because the city and the main station are important transport hubs and are particularly important due to the favourable position within the new network.







Abellio only uses trains that meet the modern comfort and technological standards. We place particularly high importance on safety and the greatest possible mobility through disabled-friendly travel. Coradia LINT (Alstom) and FLIRT (Stadler) vehicles are currently being used on our routes in North Rhine-Westphalia. In central Germany, we use the brand new Talent 2 (Bombardier) multiple units, which we will also operate in Baden-Württemberg.

> Bombardier TALENT 2

Abellio has 35 "Talent 2" trains in operation within the Saale-Thuringia-Südharz network. These were produced by the rail vehicle manufacturer Bombardier. All vehicles are air-conditioned and feature comfortable seats with spacious legroom. There are innovative lounges for groups, power outlets at the seats and signal amplifiers for mobile phones. Ticket machines and screens with the current schedule and connection times also feature on board. The Talent (abbreviation of: "Talbot leichter Nahverkehrstriebwagen", in English: Talbot light subur-

ban motor-coach) is accessed on platform level via gap bridging / step. Wheelchairs use a mobile ramp if access is not at platform level. Access to the toilets is at ground level.

The first Abellio Talent 2 in the STS network was given the name "Wartburg". A second train carries the name of the reformers Martin Luther and Thomas Müntzer through central Germany. Abellio will also implement modern Talent 2 trains into the Stuttgart network from 2019.

The diesel rail cars in the silver-black-red Abellio design set new standards in terms of comfort and dynamics. The Coradia LINT 41 by Alstom consists of two carriage segments, which are supported on a Jacobs bogie in the middle of the train. The LINT (abbreviation of: "Leichte Innovative Nahverkehrstriebwagen", in English: light innovative suburban motor-coach) has been in operation on the Bochum – Gelsenkirchen track since December

2005 and on the S 7 between Wuppertal and Solingen since 2013. Fifty-two additional Coradia LINT will also start operations from December 2018 - namely in the Saxony-Anhalt diesel network.

The LINT vehicles on the RB 46 are named after the cities of Bochum, Herne and Gelsenkirchen.

From 2018, Abellio will bring the Rhine-Ruhr-Express to the tracks. In doing so, Desiro High Capacity (HC) vehicles will be put into operation, manufactured by Siemens. The RRX trains are build by Siemens in accordance with the "NRW-RRX model", whereby the oper-

ating capacity and the vehicles are separately assigned, and are maintained over a time period of 30 years. The vehicles are leased out to Abellio under the auspices of the Rhine Ruhr Public Transportation Authority (VRR).






