HOW TO FIND US **USEFUL INFORMATION**

BY ROAD

Norden (SAT NAV BH20 5DW)

Norden is situated just off the A351 5 miles south of Wareham. 14 miles from Poole, 19 miles from Bournemouth, 22 miles from

Purbeck District Council operate a large Pay and Display Car Park.

Swanage (SAT NAV BH19 IAP)

Swanage is situated on the world heritage Jurassic coast and reached from Bournemouth or Poole via the Sandbanks - Studland Ferry or A35/

12 miles from Bournemouth or Poole (via ferry), 28 miles from Weymouth. Swanage Town Council operate large Pay and Display Car Parks.

Wareham (SAT NAV BH20 4AS)

Wareham is situated on the A351.4 miles south of the A35 Poole -Dorchester Road. 9 miles from Poole, 14 miles from Bournemouth, 19 miles from Weymouth

Due to limited car parking at Wareham Station, we recommend passengers travel to Wareham by public transport (see below)

Harmans Cross (SAT NAV BH19 3EB)

Worth Matravers Parish Council operate a small car park adjacent to

Corfe Castle and Herston Halt Stations. No station car parking available.

BY BUS

Purbeck Breezer buses from Bournemouth to Swanage (via Sandbanks Ferry) and from Poole to Corfe Castle and Swanage (via Wareham Station).

BY TRAIN

Mainline train services operate from London Waterloo, Southampton, Bournemouth, Poole, Dorchester and Weymouth to Wareham from where connecting bus services are available.

Swanage Railway operate a trial diesel service between Wareham and Swanage for 60 days during Summer 2017. See timetable pages for details.



REFRESHMENTS

The "Birds Nest Buffet" at Swanage Station is open on all train operating days serving a range of home-made cakes, snacks and drinks. At Norden Station "The Norden Kiosk" is open daily 25th March – 29th October providing a smaller range of cakes, confectionery and drinks.

TOILET FACILITIES

Toilets are available at Swanage, Corfe Castle and Norden Stations. There are no toilet facilities at Harmans Cross or Herston Halt. Disabled toilets and baby changing facilities available at Norden car park. Nearest disabled toilets to Swanage Station are at the Recreation Ground Car Park, off Rempstone Road (120 metres away) and on the seafront near the Tourist Information Centre (260 metres away).

NO SMOKING POLICY

The Swanage Railway operates a no smoking policy on all its premises and on its trains.

PUSHCHAIRS AND BUGGIES

These should be conveyed in the Guard's Van, usually located in the middle of the train, and folded if at all possible. Space is limited.

DOGS AND BICYCLES

Dogs are welcome on board but must be kept on a lead and on the floor. The Fare is £1 per single journey. There is no charge for assistance dogs. Dogs are not permitted in the Buffet or Kiosk, the Station Shop at Swanage, on dining trains or our Santa Specials (assistance dogs exempted)

Bicycles can be conveyed in the Guard's van. Space is limited and on a first come first served basis.

Passengers with a disability are welcome. Disabled access is available on most trains using a ramp to ease boarding to / from the platform. Most of our trains can carry wheelchairs but space may be limited. Disabled toilet facilities are available at Norden.

Hearing loops are available at booking offices, the shop and Birds Nest Buffet at Swanage Station.

Please note that due to the age and design of our dining carriages it is not possible for wheelchair users to remain in their wheelchairs
