GEORGE SUTTON, HANDLESS CUE STAR, IS DEAD

Sutton, 8 years old, pool and biniard expert despite a handicap imposed early in life when he lost both hands in a sawmill accident, died of a heart attack here today in his camp car. During the last year he toured the country, lecturing and appearing in exhibitions, as an employe of a Chicago haliare company.

Despite his handicap, George H. Sutton competed on equal terms with all but the very front rank of professional billiard players, and in exhibitions he had defeated some of the leaders. He had toured the country annually for thirty-five years.
