Outline Description	Art Nouveau Villa			
Property Description	The villa which is a unique example of the Art Nouveau style in Malta, was built in the			
1 5 1	early 20th century house built by Dr W. Briffa. The house was built in two phases; in 1912			
	the ground floor was built under architect Alessandro Manara, while in 1921, using the same architectural style, the first floor was by architect Emanuele Borg. The Art Nouveau			
	motifs of this building indicate a French or North Italian stylistic influence. The building			
	consists of two floors vertically divided into three. The central bay consists of a decorated			
	arched doorway at ground floor level and a pointed arched window at first floor level. The central bay is flanked on either side by a recessed panel with an arched window at			
	ground floor and first floor level. At ground floor the window is pleasantly subdivided			
	into three vertical elongated windows, while at first floor level it is subdivided in two.			
	Polychrome decorative floral motives decorate the space in the recessed panel above each window. The building is set back from the street by a boundary wall decorated by art			
	nouveau ferro battuto iron work. The villa was recently restored, and has been			
	inaugurated as a house for the Elderly in 2010.
