The result is a western-based narrative that brings a gritty yet vivid contemporary look and a visual style that echoes the song's emotional appeal.

The purpose and mission of their project is to go head-to-head with bullies.

The music video tells the story of three sad, overworked Vaudevillian performers, who are mirrored in reality as everyday people—an office receptionist, a restaurant chef, and an aspiring model—whose luck never seems to change.






