


Cholov Yisroel - Kosher supervised milk in the ingredients D - Dairy Products DE – Dairy Equipment (no actual dairy in ingredients; it can be eaten after meat) F - Fish KG – Kosher Glatt P - Passover (P never designates Pareve) PAREVE - Neutral; no Meat or Dairy Products Pas Yisroel - grain-products cooked or baked with the participation of an observant Jewish Yoshon - Not from current grain crop

Freeze dried herbs – do not require certification Cider – all natural - does not require certification Maple Syrup – that you see being made, with no other added ingredients does not require certification Honey – all natural - does not require certification
