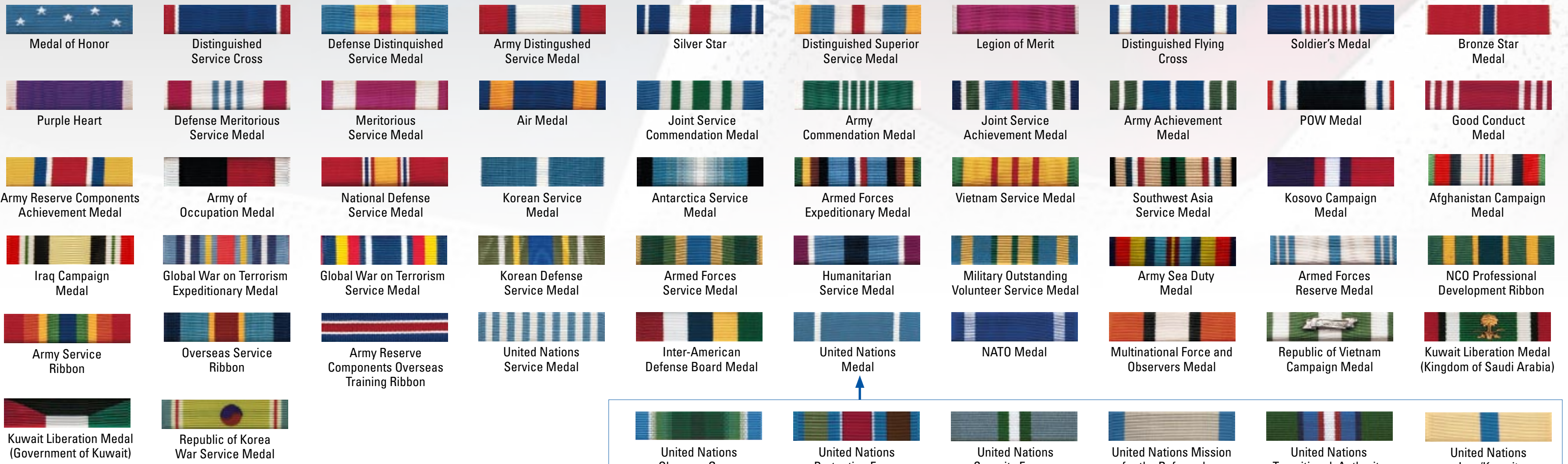

Right Side

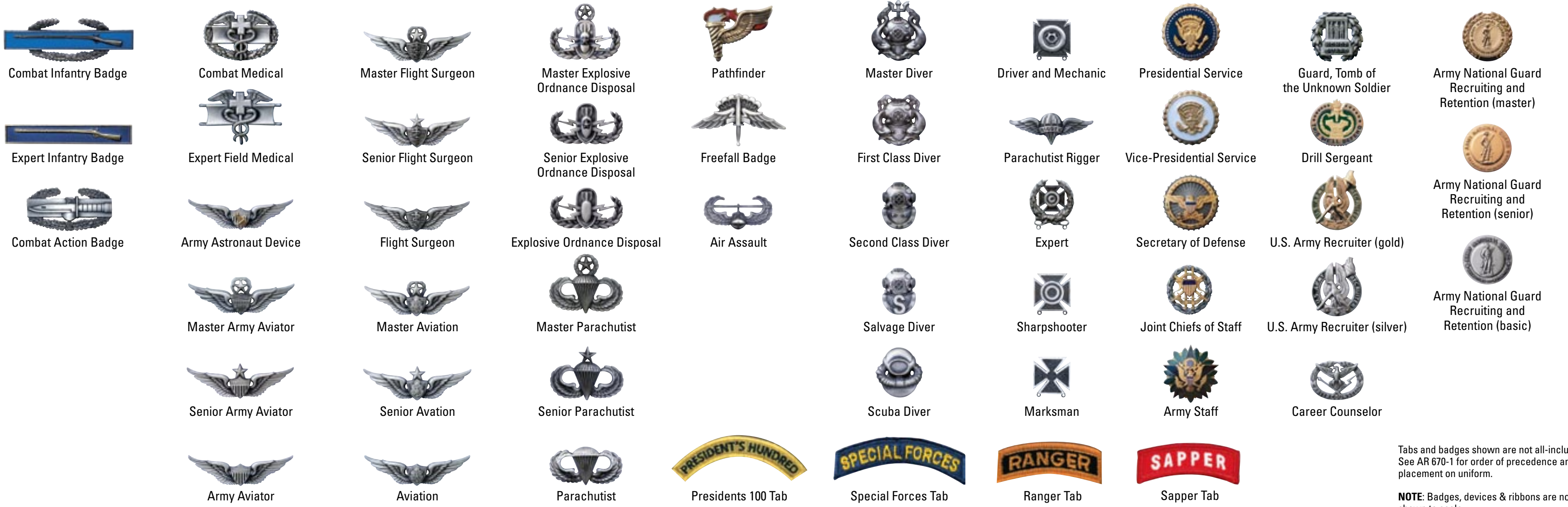


Left Side

Devices



Beret Wear & Army Service Uniform



- CHANGE: BLUE ARMY SERVICE UNIFORM (ASU)**
- The Beret is Worn with Class A, Class B and Class C Uniforms.
 - Edge binding 1 inch above eyebrows and straight across forehead. Center the flash and the stiffener above the left eye. Pull excess material down between the top and middle of right ear.
 - Hair should not extend below the front bottom edge of the beret.
 - Officers wear their rank centered on the flash. Enlisted soldiers wear their distinctive unit insignia centered on the flash.



- Tuck adjusting knot inside edge binding.
- Hair may not be packed into the beret.
- Form-fitting across the head.
- Edge binding straight across.
