REQUIREMENT

USMC Cold Weather ORD NO LOG 42.4 w/chg 1, 2, 3

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the Mountain Cold Weather boot is to be used by Marines in a multitude of operations and environments. The altitude of the environment where the boots will be used is 0 to 60,000 feet of elevation. This boot provides the ability to kick steps in snow and ice due to the impregnated leather toe cap. The boot can perform on varying degrees of slopes from 0-90 degrees and a variety of terrain types to include but not limited to rock, loose soil, mud, snow and alpine ice. The boot will provide good traction for maneuverability in the above environments and terrain.

FIELDING STATUS

Currently there is no intent from MarCarSysCom to field the Mountain Cold Weather boot. The boot has been approved by MarCorSysCom, units are authorized to purchase using unit funds to support their requirement. The boot is manufactured by Danner Footwear Inc and is available for immediate purchase.

FEATURES

Basic rifleman skills in mountain cold weather / mountain operations such as hiking, snowshoeing, backcountry movements on skis and moderate rock climbing. Life expectancy of 1 year in normal condition that the boots were intended for. The boot will support a load of 100 additional pounds not counting the naked body wait. The boot is designed to provide a level of comfort up to + 20 Degrees F with an insulated sock being used.

TRAINING

No training involved.

SUPPLY LOGISTICS

NSNs: Since this item is not sustained through the supply system, there are no NSNs. Basic tariff sizes apply from manufacture, as well as special orders if needed.
