CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2016, became the first Bears QB to throw for over 300 yds. in four consecutive games [317 yds. at Dal. (9/25); 302 yds. vs. Det. (10/2); 397 yds. at Ind. (10/9); 302 vs. Jax. (10/16)] in franchise history.
- Became the first QB in Texans history to throw 2-or-more TD passes in five consecutive games [2 at Atl. (10/4/15); 2 vs. Ind. (10/8/15); 3 at Jax. (10/18/15); 3 at Mia. 10/25/15); 2 vs. Ten. (11/1/15)].
- As a member of the Cleveland Browns in 2014, ranked first in the NFL, averaging 13.74 yds. per completion.
- In 2013, became the first QB in Browns history to win each of his first three starts with the team.

HOYER'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Won a celebrity cooking competition in 2014 where the contestants were tasked with the challenge of creating a three-course meal for 20 judges. His menu consisted of mussels, a grilled romaine salad, truffle beef tenderloin and grilled vegetables.
- Hoyer grew up a Cleveland Browns fan in North Olmsted, OH, and attended the final game at Cleveland Stadium on December 17, 1995, before the team moved to Baltimore. In 2013, Hoyer signed with his hometown team and became the first QB in Browns history to win his first three starts with the club.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS

- Completed 23 of 37 atts. for 332 yds., 2 TDs, 1 INT and a QB rating of 98.0 vs. LAR (9/21). His 332 passing yds. marked the second-highest single-game total in his career [397 yds. at Ind. (10/9/16)]. It also marked Hoyer's 10th career 300-yd. passing game and first as a member of the 49ers.
- Also registered a 9-yd. TD run in the 1st qtr. vs. LAR (9/21), marking the 2nd rushing TD of his career, and first since his NFL debut with the New England Patriots (10/18/09 - 1 yd. TD).
- Completed 29 of 46 passing atts. for 353 yds., 2 TDs and a passer rating of 101.1 at Ind. (10/8). It marked the first time he registered a passer rating of 100-or-more as a member of the 49ers and his most passing yds. with the team. His 353 passing yds. were the 2nd-most in a single game in his career [at Ind. (10/9/16) - 397 yds.].

GOLDMINE

- Early into his tenure as a member of the 49ers, Hoyer dove right into community work in the Bay Area, participating in multiple events. In partnership with “Super Baskets of Hope,” Hoyer, along with teammates WR Pierre Garçon and RB Carlos Hyde, distributed baskets and totes filled with toys, educational materials, games, craft items, music, stuffed animals, gift cards, and more to hospitalized children and their families at a local Bay Area Hospital. Parents were given a Basket of Hope, donated by Vera Bradley, filled with items to nourish them physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually. Hoyer spent time with the children and their families while delivering the gift baskets in an effort to spread joy and inspiration during a difficult time.



- In 2014, Hoyer won a celebrity cooking competition, defeating comedian Rick Smith at the Lago Restaurant and Wine Bar in Cleveland, OH. Hoyer and Smith were tasked with the challenge of creating a three-course meal in front of 20 judges. The catch was that all of the dishes had to be prepared on the grill. Hoyer’s menu consisted of mussels, a grilled romaine salad, truffle beef tenderloin and grilled vegetables. Smith whipped together a shrimp and mussels pizza, fish tacos wrapped in lettuce and lamb chops. Random Acts of Kindness Everywhere (R.A.K.E.) sponsored the event to raise money for the 11 Foundation, which helps identify and support families of Pediatric Traumatic Brain Injuries.

- Growing up in North Olmsted, OH, just outside of Cleveland, Hoyer was a big fan of the hometown Indians. Hoyer had the opportunity to meet Indians catcher Sandy Alomar Jr. when he was a child and, 15 years later as a member of the Cleveland Browns, he threw out the first pitch at an Indians game on July 12, 2014, to Alomar Jr.

- Recorded his 5th career 300-yd. game vs. Ind. (10/8), despite not entering the game until the 2nd Qtr. Completed 24 of 31 atts. for 312 yds., 2 TDs and a QB rating of 116.6.

Played in 13 games and completed 223 of 376 atts. for 2,725 yds. and 20 TDs. As a sophomore, saw action in 8 games and completed 82 of 144 atts. for 863 yds. and 4 TDs. In 2005, played in 5 games and completed 15 of 23 atts. for 167 yds. and 2 TDs. Redshirted in 2004.
