

B9 Fishers of Men, Mark 2:14-20, Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

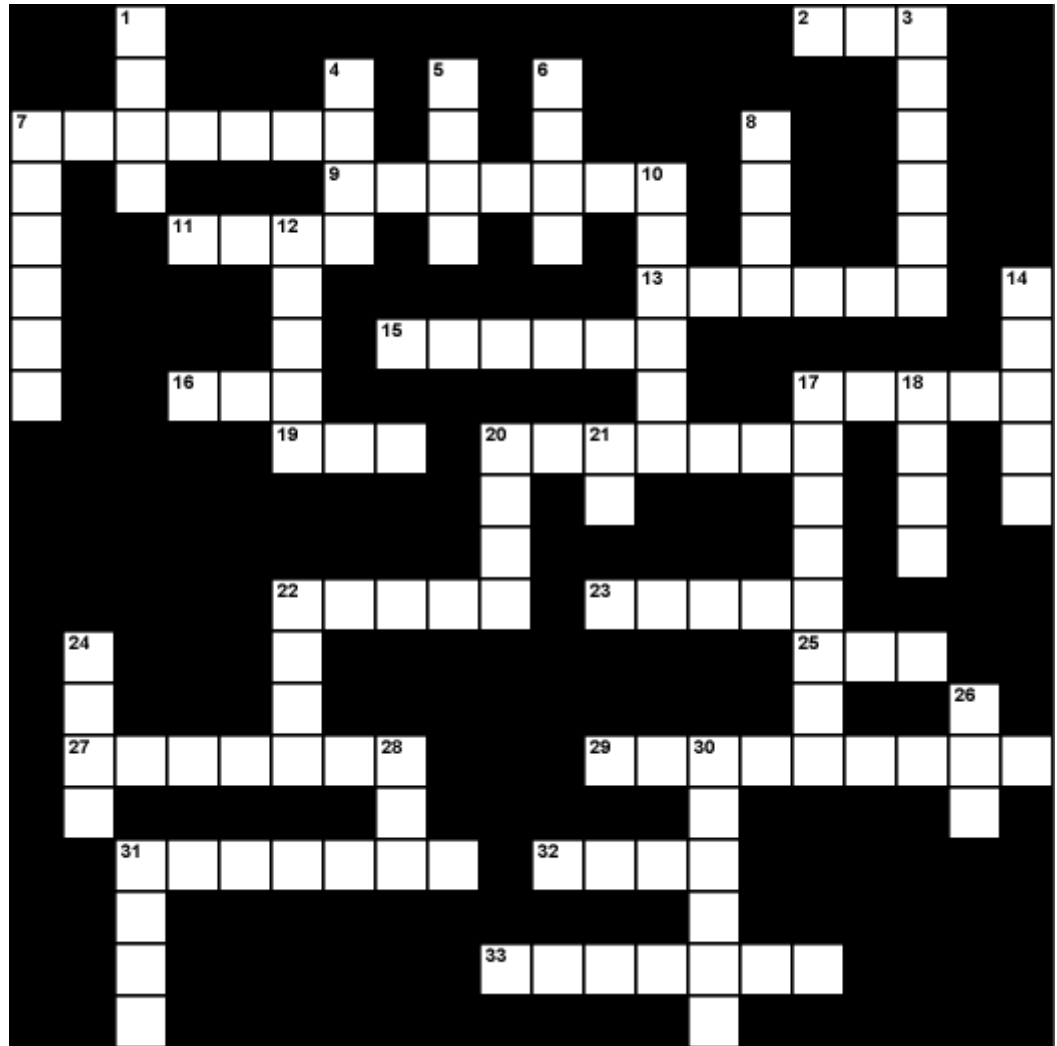
