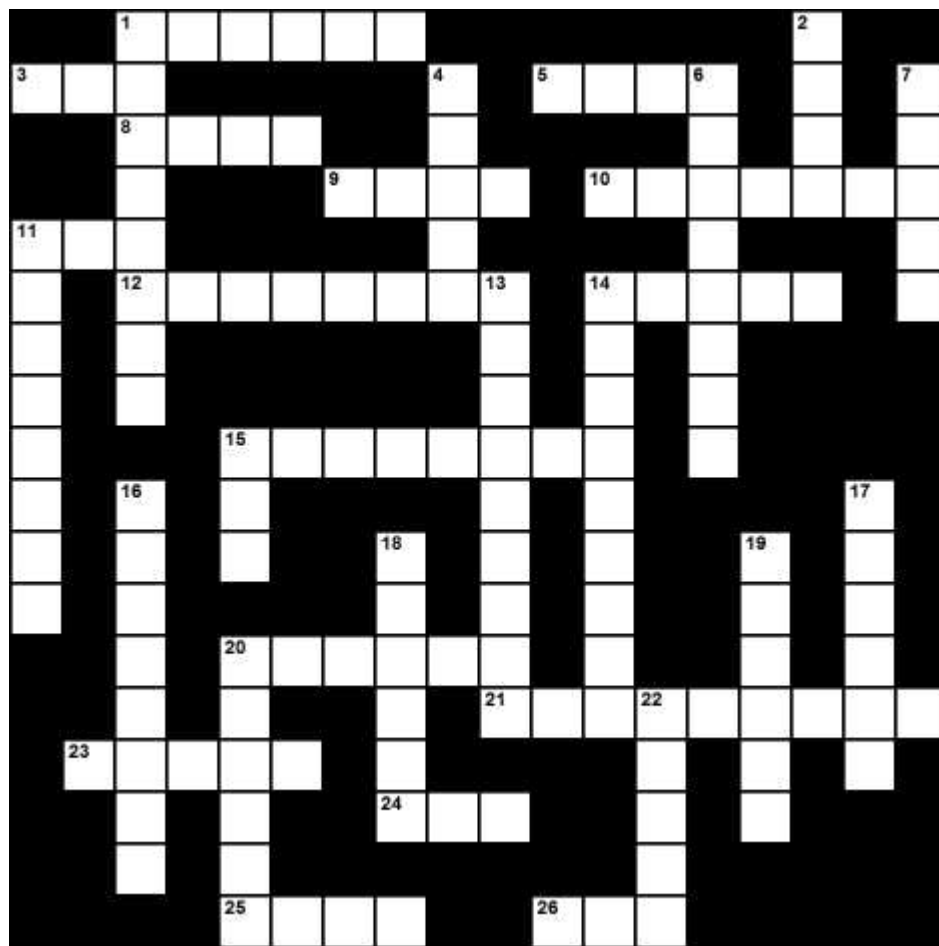


**C29 Loaves and Fishes, Luke 9:11-17,
