R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, After serving three distinguished terms as a member
2 of the Texas House of Representatives, the Honorable Rick Perry
3 will be retiring from the Texas Legislature, and his outstanding
4 legislative ability will be missed by his colleagues and by the
5 people he served in the state; and

6 WHEREAS, While a member of the house, this outstanding Texan
7 has earned the respect and friendship of his legislative colleagues
8 and has represented his constituents in District 64 with integrity
9 and conscientiousness; and

10 WHEREAS, A native of Haskell, he was graduated from Texas A&M
11 University with a bachelor's degree in animal science in 1972 and,
12 following graduation, entered the United States Air Force;
13 graduating in the top third of his pilot training class in 1973, he
14 went on to serve his country as an aircraft commander in Europe,
15 South America, and Africa; and

16 WHEREAS, First winning election to the Texas House of
17 Representatives in 1984, he has exercised his leadership abilities
18 as chairman of budget and oversight for both the Committee on
19 Energy and the Committee on Judicial Affairs and has served as an
20 active member of many other key committees, including the
21 Appropriations Committee, the House Calendars Committee, and the
22 Agriculture and Livestock Committee; and

23 WHEREAS, Appointed to serve on the Texas Legislative Council
24 in 1989, he also shares his valuable insight and expertise as a

1 member of the Southwest Energy Council and the Energy Committee of
2 the National Conference of State Legislatures; and

3 WHEREAS, A man of many interests, Representative Perry is a
4 dedicated civic leader in Haskell, where he lives with his wife,
5 Anita, and their two children, Griffin and Sydney; and

6 WHEREAS, Representative Perry serves on the board of
7 directors of the Haskell National Bank, the Junior Livestock
8 Association, and the Tri-Area Junior Livestock Association and is a
9 member of the Haskell Chamber of Commerce and the Lions Club; and

10 WHEREAS, A farmer and rancher by profession, his many talents
11 and abilities are widely recognized in numerous organizations,
12 including the Texas Farm Bureau, the Texas Southwestern Cattle
13 Raisers Association, the Texas State Rifle Association, the
14 National Rifle Association, and the Texas Association of Wheat
15 Growers; and

16 WHEREAS, During his tenure in office, Representative Perry
17 has proven himself to be a great asset to the legislative process
18 and his outstanding efforts in this regard have earned him such
19 accolades as being named one of the 10 most effective lawmakers by
20 the Dallas Morning News and inclusion on the honor roll of best
21 legislators compiled by the Young Conservatives of Texas; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative Perry has consistently worked to
23 promote legislation to benefit all Texans and it is appropriate
24 that the members of the house of representatives recognize their
25 esteemed colleague for his outstanding legislative service; now,
