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## Obama on cruise control in MA—unless Romney is GOP nom

**Raleigh, N.C.** –Even though PPP shows Republican Scott Brown in strong shape for reelection, it appears President Obama can once again make Massachusetts fly-over country in 2012. That is, unless their former governor Mitt Romney is the GOP's choice.

In a reminder of how much stronger candidate Obama is and how much weaker the current GOP presidential frontrunners are than many of their respective state-level counterparts, the president has an almost 2:1 lead over Sarah Palin, 61-32, and he leads Mike Huckabee and Newt Gingrich by identical 57-33 margins. Against Romney, however, the president's advantage is only 52-43—still strong in just about any state but a far less healthy lead than Democrats typically get in the deeply blue Bay State.

Romney is the only of the four who leads the president with independents (52-41); Palin trails 37-54, Gingrich 38-49, and Huckabee 38-48. Unlike in some other states where he does best with independents but worst with Republicans, however, Romney also performs strongest among his own state's more moderate Republicans, and here by far. He pulls 85% of the GOP, far higher than Gingrich's 72%, Huckabee's 70%, and Palin's 67%. Romney also takes 15% of Democrats, with the others at only 10 or 11%. If it were not such a heavily Democratic state, the internals suggest Romney would have a significant lead over Obama, not the other way around.

Obama's job approval rating is 55-40, up there with Maryland and California at the top of his standings in the 33 states PPP has polled in 2010. But whereas hardly anyone who disapproves of his job performance voted for Democrats last month, a decent number prefer Obama to all the Republicans but Romney. Palin is the least popular personally, as in most states, with a 27-68 favorability rating, followed by Gingrich's 27-58, then Huckabee's 29-48, and Romney's 40-51.

"Even if Mitt Romney was the Republican nominee in 2012 it doesn't look like Massachusetts would be all that competitive," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "It's going to be a long time before a GOP candidate wins the state in a Presidential race."

PPP surveyed 500 Massachusetts voters from November 29<sup>th</sup> to December 1<sup>st</sup>. The survey's margin of error is +/-4.4%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
