Minutes of the Second and Adjourned Twenty-Third Regular Monthly Meeting of the State Highway Commission, held in the State Office Building, with the following members present:

R. M. Hubbard, Chairman of the Commission,
C. N. Avery, Commissioner of Construction,
C. S. Fowler, Commissioner of Registration,
George A. Duren, State Highway Engineer.

The following business was transacted:

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that an intercounty highway be designated, beginning at Naples, thence to Daingerfield, thence to Ore City, thence to James, thence to Longview. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Highway No. 43 be designated, beginning about fifteen miles north of Longview, on the Culberson Highway, thence south to Longview, thence south to Henderson, thence to Rusk in Cherokee county, and intersecting Highway No. 22. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Tom Greene county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon the passage of the proposed bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 30 be further designated and extended as follows: From Paint Rock via Eden, thence to Menard, thence to Junction, thence to Leake, thence to Sabinal. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Sutton county be granted \$100,000 Federal Aid, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon the passage of the proposed bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Val Verde county be granted \$100,000 Federal Aid, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract, and conditioned upon the passage of a bond issue of not less than \$400,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that all State and Federal Aid heretofore granted Freestone county on Highway No. 7, beginning at Limestone and going east ten miles to Teague be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Freestone county be granted \$37,500 Federal Aid on Highway No. 7, in Road District No. 1, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Uvalde county be granted the sum of \$100,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon the passage of the proposed bond issue of \$400,000.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler that all State Aid heretofore granted Haskell county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Avery that \$8,043.50 State Aid be granted Haskell county, not to exceed 25 per cent of the cost of construction of Highway No. 39, from the City of Haskell to the Stonewall county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that \$18,000 Federal Aid be granted Haskell county on Highway No. 39, from the city of Haskell to the Throckmorton county line, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Hill county be granted \$51,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 31, from county line to county line, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Coleman county be granted \$25,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 7, in Road District No. 3, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon the passage by said District of a bond issue in an amount not less than \$100,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Galveston county be granted \$3,500 additional Federal Aid on Highway No. 2, beginning at the Harris county line, thence south five and one-half miles to Dickenson, making the total allotment \$12,500, not to exceed 50 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Galveston county be granted \$75,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract, and conditioned upon the passage of a bond issue of not less than \$400,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Hubbard, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Liberty county be granted \$75,000 Federal Aid, on Highway No. 35, between the city of Liberty and north to the county line, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon a \$200,000 bond issue. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Hardin county be granted \$37,500 Federal Aid on Highway No. 40, from the Tyler county line to Kountz, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Hardin county be granted \$56,250 Federal Aid on Highway No. 40, from Jefferson county line north to Kountz, not to exceed 50 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Hemphill county be granted \$20,000 ^{Fed. Aid.} on Highway No. 4, from Canadian to the Lipscomb county line, not to exceed 50 per cent of the contract.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Rusk county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid upon State Highways, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract, and conditioned upon the passage of the proposed bond issue of \$800,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that all Aid heretofore granted Anderson county be canceled. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Anderson county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid on State Highways, conditioned upon the passage of a bond issue of \$1,270,000, and not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Bastrop county be granted \$11,961.00 Federal Aid on Highway No. 20, Road District No. 3, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Bastrop county be granted \$13,691.50 Federal Aid on Highway No. 20, Road District No. 4, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Bastrop county be granted \$10,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 20, Road District No. 8, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Lee county be granted \$4,000 additional State Aid on Highway No. 20, from county line to county line. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that Highway No. 4 be extended south from Sonora to the W. T. O. Holman Ranch, thence by the west branch south to Del Rio, the east branch extending from the W. T. O. Holman Ranch southeast through Rock Springs, thence to Barksdale, thence to Uvalde. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that McLennan county be granted \$18,000 Federal Aid on Highway No. 31, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract, said highway to be built out of Federal Aid. Motion carried.


Motion by Mr. Avery, seconded by Mr. Fowler that Tyler county be granted \$200,000 Federal Aid, not to exceed 25 per cent of the contract and conditioned upon the passage of a bond issue of not less than \$800,000. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Fowler, seconded by Mr. Avery that the resolution passed on February 18th, 1919, with reference to the Austin-Fredericksburg Road be amended by adding thereto the following:


It being made to appear to the Commission that Blanco county has voted a bond issue since the entry of said order, it is therefore ordered by the Commission that the amount of Federal Aid granted to said Blanco county shall become available immediately subject to the regular procedure, and provided further that said allotment shall not exceed 50 per cent of the cost of the project.

Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, adjournment was taken until April 24th.
