Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Bexar County be granted \$66,220.88 Federal Aid and \$33,110.44 State Aid on Highway No.3 west of San Antonio. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Armistead, seconded by Mr. Martin that Bexar County be granted \$58,53858Federal Aid and \$18,846.18 State Aid to Highway No.3 east of San Antonic, F.A.P. 398. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Armistead that Brazoria County be granted \$74,400 State Aid to F.A.P. 367 on Highway No.19. Motion carried.
