



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Winter Shades Hat & Scarf

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat Circumference: 20 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Hat Depth: 9"

Scarf Width: 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Scarf Length: 58"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Uptown Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds

- 354 Granite (MC) – 2 balls

Universal Yarn Classic Shades Metallic (69% acrylic, 29% wool, 2% metallic; 100g/175 yds)

- 605 Umbrella (CC) – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 32" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 6 (4 mm) 32" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

16 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Slip Stitch Pattern using larger ndl

16 sts x 32 rows = 4" in garter stitch using MC and smaller ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The scarf is worked lengthwise.

The hat is knit flat and seamed.

When working the Slip Stitch Pattern, slip all stitches purlwise with the yarn held to the wrong side of the work.

STITCH GUIDE

Slip Stitch Pattern

(multiple of 4 sts + 3)

Row 1 (RS): With CC k3, [sl 1, k3] to end.

Row 2 (WS): Rep Row 1.

Rows 3-4: With MC k1, [sl 1, k3] to last 2 sts, sl 1, k1.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

K1, P1 Ribbing

(odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p1, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P2, * k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

SCARF

With MC and smaller ndl, cast on 231 sts. Knit 3 rows. Switch to larger ndl. Rep Rows 1-4 of Slip Stitch Pattern, 12 times, then rep Rows 1-2, 2 times. Switch to smaller ndl. With MC, knit 3 rows. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

HAT

With smaller ndl, cast on 83 sts. Beg with Row 1, work in K1, P1 Ribbing patt for 2", ending with WS row. Switch to larger ndl. Beg with Row 1, work in Slip Stitch Pattern until piece meas 7 ½" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 4 of patt. Break MC, cont in CC only. Switch to smaller ndl.

Shape Crown

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (WS): K9, k2tog, [k8, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 75 sts rem.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K8, k2tog, [k7, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 67 sts rem.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: K7, k2tog, [k6, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 59 sts rem.

Row 7: K6, k2tog, [k5, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 51 sts rem.

Row 8: K5, k2tog, [k4, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 43 sts rem.

Row 9: K4, k2tog, [k3, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 35 sts rem.

Row 10: K3, k2tog, [k2, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 27 sts rem.

Row 11: K2, k2tog, [k1, k2tog] 7 times, k2 – 19 sts rem.

Row 12: K1, [k2tog] 8 times, k2 – 11 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving 16" tail. Pass tail through rem live sts, pull taut. Sew side seam.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

WS	wrong side



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
