### Methodology

Online survey conducted with Canadian citizens across all regions of Canada.

This study was conducted online across all Canadian regions with 1,534 Canadians who are eligible to vote, between October 23 and October 25, 2017.

#### **Weighting and Margin of Error**

Final survey data were weighted based on the 2011 census according to age, gender, mother tongue, region, and level of education in order to guarantee a representative sample of the Canadian population.

For comparative purposes, a random sample of **1,534** would yield a margin of error of **+/- 2,5%**, 19 times out of 20.

### **Online Survey**

Survey respondents were selected randomly from LegerWeb's Internet panel, which includes 400,000 Canadian households, and according to a stratification process applied to invitation lists, optimal respondent which ensures representativeness. Panelists were recruited randomly from Leger's telephone surveys. Several quality control measures were implemented to ensure that Leger's surveys with Internet panelists are representative and reliable. Leger has obtained Gold Seal Certification from the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association, the highest reliability rating conferred by the association.
