Meetings in Brazil and in Europe

This week, the confreres of the District of Brazil met in Belo Horizonte for the District Assembly. They spent five days together to share the joys and challenges of 2014, to reflect on their mission, and to develop plans for



the coming year. With a renewed spirit and the desire to be Mary's presence in Brazil, they defined the theme of the mission of the district for 2015: "Marists, together in joy and in the desire to be a support for the Church".

In Europe the Council of the Province took place this week, with the members of the European provincial administration, the regional superiors and Fr Alejandro Muñoz from the GA. The main item on the agenda was new provincial legislation designed to encourage greater unity. Attention was also given to a recent letter from the superior general, vocations, finance and the life and mission of the province.
