On Saturday, Fr John Hannan travels to Washington to attend a meeting of the provincials of North America with their councils on reconfiguration and inter-unit cooperation.

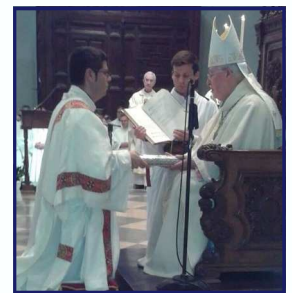
