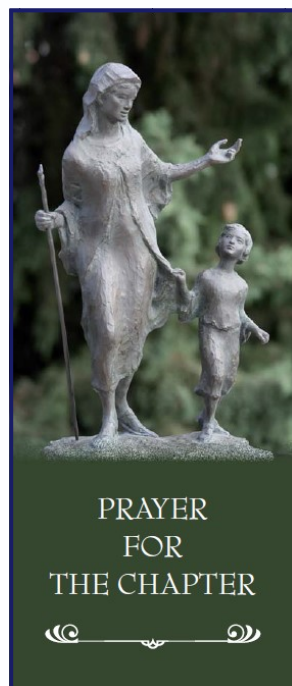
## General Administration
