FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Monmouth for the first time.
- The game is part of the NIT Season Tip-Off.
- UVA has started 3-0 for the second straight season and is 103-33 (.757) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- Kyle Guy is averaging a team-leading 19.7 points and is shooting 53.3 percent (8-of-15) from 3-point range.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy scored a career-high 29 points to lift Virginia to a 76-67 win at VCU on Friday, Nov. 17.
- Guy drilled 11 of 20 shots, including five 3-pointers, and added a career-high four steals in UVA's second straight win against VCU.
- Ty Jerome added a season-high 13 points and career-best seven
- Isaac Vann led three VCU players in double figures with 19 points.
- UVA shot 50.8 percent (31-of-61) from the floor and 43.5 percent (10-23) from 3-point range.
- Isaiah Wilkins chipped in eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took three charges.
- The Cavaliers committed a season-low five turnovers and had 18 fast break points.
- UVA added 16 points off 12 VCU turnovers.
- VCU outrebounded UVA 36-26.

ALL-TIME VS. METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE FOES

- Virginia meets a member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference for the first time since posting a 54-45 win over Fairfield during the 2012-13 cascon
- UVA is 8-0 all-time against current Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference members (3-0 vs. Fairfield, 1-0 vs. Canisius, 1-0 vs. Iona, 1-0 vs. Manhattan, 1-0 vs. Rider and 1-0 vs. Siena).
- Tony Bennett is 2-0 all-time vs. Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference opponents at Virginia (79-46 win over Rider in 2009 and 54-45 win over Fairfield in 2012).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 152-40 (.792), including a 2-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 114-24 (.826), including a 79-9 (.898) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 41-4 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA is allowing 54.7 points per game and has held two of its 2017-18 opponents to fewer than 50 points, limiting UNCG to 48 points and Austin Peay 49.
- The Cavaliers are 66-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 91-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

UVA RECEIVING VOTES IN RANKINGS

- UVA received votes in the first Associated Press regular-season poll and USA Today Coaches' preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the preseason rankings in both polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014–16).
- Last season, the Cavaliers ranked No. 24 in the final AP poll and received votes in the USA Today Coaches' poll.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 191-83 (.697) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 260-116 (.691) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 103-33 (.757) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 114-24 (.826) at home under Tony Bennett.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia returns three starters Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt and five other letterwinners including Kyle Guy, Ty Jerome and Mamadi Diakite from last year's 23-11 team that advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt in each of its first three games.
- Hall is UVA's top returning scorer at 8.4 points per game, which marks the third time in school history that UVA started the season without a returning double-digit scorer (1998-99, Colin Ducharme averaged 7.8 ppg in 1997-98 and 1969-70, Chip Case averaged 7.2 ppg in 1968-69).
- Guy leads UVA in scoring at 19.7 points per game and is shooting 51.4 percent from the floor, including 53.3 percent from 3-point range
- Hall is averaging 13.3 points and 4.7 rebounds, while point guard Ty Jerome is averaging 8.3 points and a team-leading 3.0 assists.
- Wilkins is averaging 7.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.0 blocked shots.
- Salt is averaging 4.0 points and 3.3 rebounds, while graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 7.7 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Diakite (3.7 ppg & 3.0 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (5.0 ppg) and Jay Huff (9.0 ppg) are key contributors off the bench.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins leads UVA in rebounding (8.0 rpg) and blocked shots (1.0 bpg), and has added 7.0 points per game.
- Wilkins has grabbed eight rebounds and two assists in each of UVA's three games.
- \bullet He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging 13.3 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists in 28.3 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting a blistering 54.2 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent from 3-point range and perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged career highs in points (8.4), rebounds (4.4), 3-point percentage (37.2%), free throw percentage (77.6%) and minutes (27.4).
- Hall, who has started 57 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 21 career games including two games this season.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy leads Virginia in scoring (19.7 ppg) after scoring a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- Guy's 29 points were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has scored 14 or more points in each of UVA's three games this season
- Guy is shooting 50 percent (59-of-118) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five 3-pointers in four games.
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 14 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt (3/8/17) and Grambling State (11/22/16)
- Guy shot a team-high 49.5 percent from 3-point range in 2016-17.

BENNETT NAMES CAPTAINS FOR FIRST TIME

- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett named Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt tri-captains for the 2017-18 season.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.

THE ELECTRIC 70s

• Virginia is 97-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 94-77 when scoring under 70 points.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 66-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (2-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 91-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held four opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale, Grambling State and Robert Morris) under 40 points in 2016-17 and is 18-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

- Seven of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, North Carolina, Miami, Notre Dame, Louisville, Seton Hall, and West Virginia), while three (Rhode Island, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight seasons of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

RECORDS WATCH

- Isaiah Wilkins ranks 11th on UVA's career blocked shots list with 95.
 Wilkins needs three blocks to pass Chris Williams (97 blocks, 1999-02) for 10th on the list.
- **CAVALIERS IN THE NBA**
- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Washington) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee last season.
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.
- London Perrantes (2014-17) signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and is currently playing in the G-League for the Canton Charge.

- The 6-7, 178-pound Stattmann averaged 31 points to lead the Australian U17 Emus Men's Basketball Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Oceania Championships in Guam.
