Historical Context	James Gallagher selected forty acres in Dundowran in 1877. The Gallagher family, which included James, William and Martin, eventually selected approximately 500 acres of the land in the Dundowran area. The name of the area was originally 'Dundowerung', but the Gallaghers' named their property Dundowran, for which the locality is now known.			
Physical Description	The graves of a number of the Gallagher family and William and Annie Bagnell are located in an area of sugar cane cultivation. The grave site is covered with concrete and surrounded by a chain fence. The grave site is marked by a plaque.
