Montecito and Summerland Area-south of Hwy 192, north of Hwy 101, west of Toro Cyn, east of Summit Rd and Country Club. Montecito north of Alameda Padre Serra/Hwy 101, south of Hwy 192, east of Mission Canyon Road and west of Hot Springs and Summit Road.  CITY OF VENTURA North of Foothill Road from Cobble Road to Kimball Road. As of 1000 hours, all mandatory and voluntary evacuations orders have been lifted.  UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF FILLMORE Sespe Creek to the west, Burson Ranch to the east, Fillmore City limits to the south, and Los Padres National Forest boundary to the north.				
	UNINCORPORATED VENTURA COUNTY Residents and day visitors of Rose Valley  VENTURA COUNTY NORTH COAST AREA The areas of Highway 150 between Santa Ana and Highway 192 is still in an evacuation order but is now accessible to residents only.
